Point #1:

**Grace doesn't mean we have a license
to sin.**

We have no license to sin

(Romans 6:15 NIV) What then? Shall we sin because we are not under law but under grace? By no means!

Jesus is our Lord

(Jude 1:4 NIV) For certain men whose condemnation was written about long ago have secretly slipped in among you. They are godless men, who change the grace of our God into a license for immorality and deny Jesus Christ our only Sovereign and Lord.

Point #2:

You are either a slave to sin or a slave to righteousness.

We are slaves to whom we obey

(Romans 6:16 NIV) Don't you know that when you offer yourselves to someone to obey him as slaves, you are slaves to the one whom you obey--whether you are slaves to sin, which leads to death, or to obedience, which leads to righteousness?

We can not serve two masters

(Mat 6:24 NIV) "No one can serve two masters. Either he will hate the one and love the other, or he will be devoted to the one and despise the other. You cannot serve both God and Money."

Slaves to sin

(John 8:34 NIV) Jesus replied, "I tell you the truth, everyone who sins is a slave to sin."

Freedom or Slavery

(2 Pet 2:19 NIV) They promise them freedom, while they themselves are slaves of depravity--for a man is a slave to whatever has mastered him.

Point #3:

Compare the benefits _____.

What benefit did you reap?

(Romans 6:21-22 NIV) What benefit did you reap at that time from the things you are now ashamed of? Those things result in death! But now that you have been set free from sin and have become slaves to God, the benefit you reap leads to holiness, and the result is eternal life.

A man reaps what he sows

(Gal 6:7-8 NIV) Do not be deceived: God cannot be mocked. A man reaps what he sows. The one who sows to please his sinful nature, from that nature will reap destruction; the one who sows to please the Spirit, from the Spirit will reap eternal life.

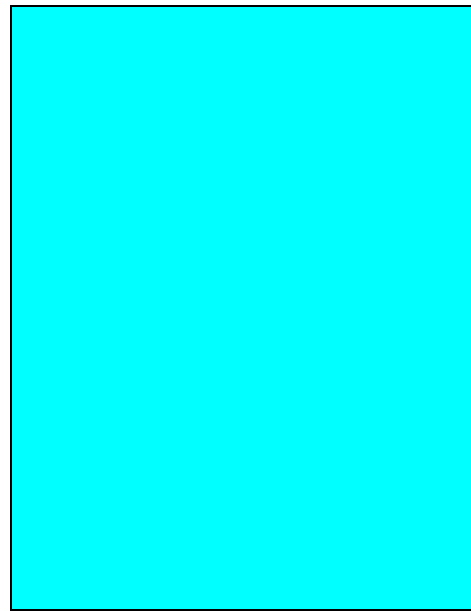
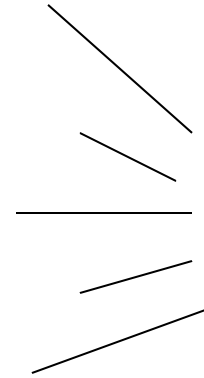
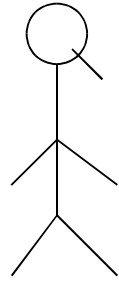

The wages of sin is death.

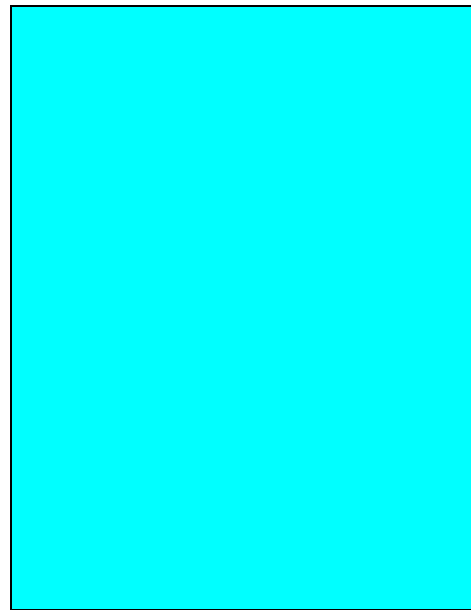
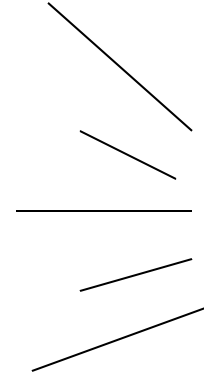
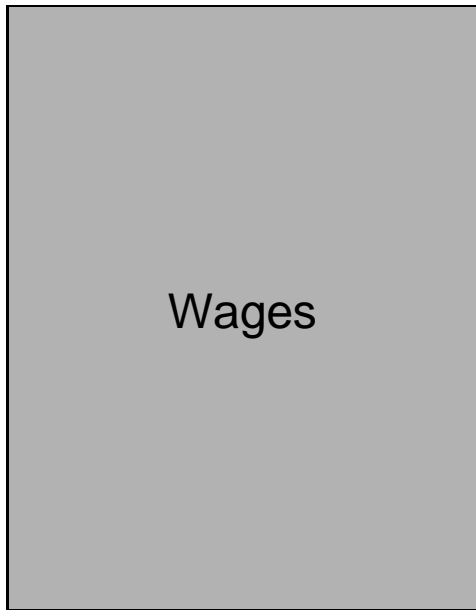
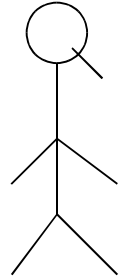

(Romans 6:23 NIV) For the wages of sin is death, but the gift of God is eternal life in Christ Jesus our Lord.

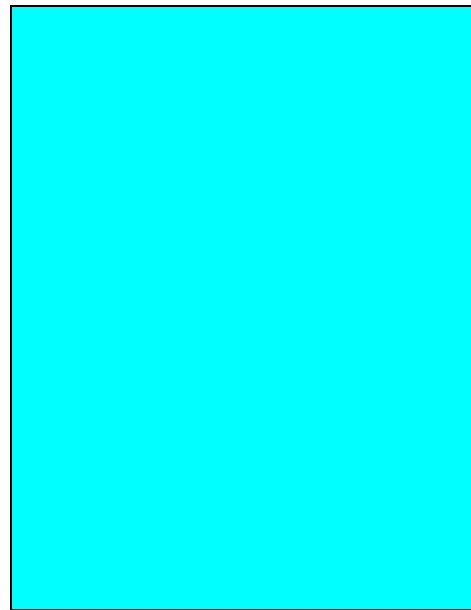
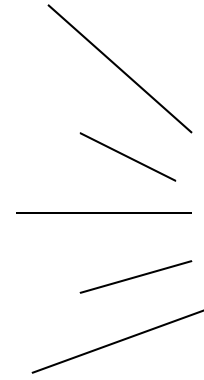
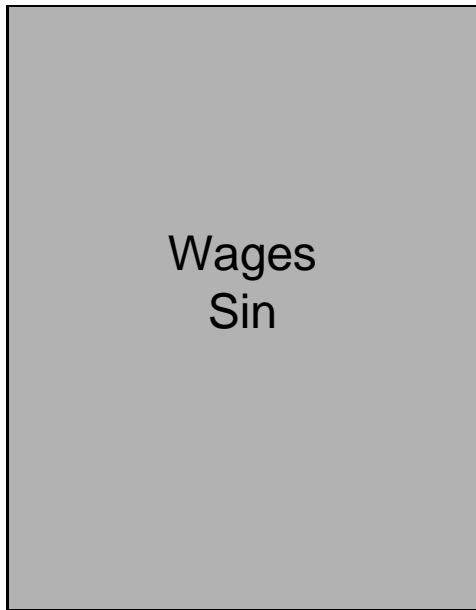
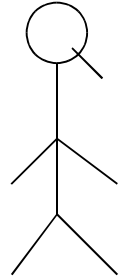
