

1 Corinthians 15:1-8

Point 1 **Sin** wrecks everything.

...for our sins...

(1 Cor 15:1-8 ESV) For I delivered to you as of first importance what I also received: that Christ died for our sins in accordance with the Scriptures.

Point 2

Christ died for our sins according to the scriptures.

...according to the scriptures

(1 Cor 15:1-8 ESV) For I delivered to you as of first importance what I also received: that Christ died for our sins in accordance with the Scriptures.

Takes away the sin of the world

(John 1:29 ESV) The next day he saw Jesus coming toward him, and said, "Behold, the Lamb of God, who takes away the sin of the world

He bore our sins

(1 Pet 2:24 ESV) He himself bore our sins in his body on the tree, that we might die to sin and live to righteousness. By his wounds you have been healed.

The Lord has laid on him the iniquity of us all.

(Isa 53:5-6 ESV) But he was wounded for our transgressions; he was crushed for our iniquities; upon him was the chastisement that brought us peace, and with his stripes we are healed. All we like sheep have gone astray; we have turned—every one to his own way; and the Lord has laid on him the iniquity of us all.

Old Testament fulfilled in the New

Betrayed for 30 pieces of Silver (Zech. 11:13, Mat 26:15)

Soldiers gambled for his clothes (Ps 22:16-17, John 19:24)

With the wicked when he died (Isa 53:9, Mat 27:38)

His hands and feet pierced (Ps 22:16, John 20:25)

He was mocked by enemies (Ps 22:7, Mat 27:39-42)

He was thirsty (Ps 22:15, John 19:28)

He was given gall to drink (Ps 69:21, Mat 27:34)

His side was pierced (Zec 12:10, John 19:34)

They did not break his legs. (Ps. 34:20, John 19:33)

He was with the rich in his death (Isa 53:9, Luke 23:53)

Point 3

Raised on **third day** according to the scriptures

Third day

(1 Cor 15:4 ESV) that he was buried, that he was raised on the third day in accordance with the Scriptures,

Proof through His resurrection

(Acts 17:31 NIV) For he has set a day when he will judge the world with justice by the man he has appointed. He has given proof of this to all men by raising him from the dead."

Jesus predicted it

(Mat 12:40 NIV) For as Jonah was three days and three nights in the belly of a huge fish, so the Son of Man will be three days and three nights in the heart of the earth.

Predicted in Isaiah

(Isa 53:11 NIV) After the suffering of his soul, he will see the light of life and be satisfied; by his knowledge my righteous servant will justify many, and he will bear their iniquities.

Predicted in Hosea

(Hosea 6:2 NIV) After two days he will revive us; on the third day he will restore us, that we may live in his presence.

Predicted in Psalms

(Psa 16:10 NIV) because you will not abandon me to the grave, nor will you let your Holy One see decay.

Point 4

Jesus presented Himself <u>alive</u>.

He appeared to many

(1 Cor 15:5-8 ESV) and that he appeared to Cephas, then to the twelve. Then he appeared to more than five hundred brothers at one time, most of whom are still alive, though some have fallen asleep. Then he appeared to James, then to all the apostles. Last of all, as to one untimely born, he appeared also to me

Jesus appeared to them

(Luke 24:33-36 ESV) And they got up that very hour and returned to Jerusalem, and found gathered together the eleven and those who were with them, saying, "The Lord has really risen and has appeared to Simon." They began to relate their experiences on the road and how He was recognized by them in the breaking of the bread. While they were telling these things, He Himself stood in their midst and said to them. "Peace be to you."

Jesus presented himself alive

(Acts 1:3 ESV) To these He also presented Himself alive after His suffering, by many convincing proofs, appearing to them over a period of forty days and speaking of the things concerning the kingdom of God

Application

(1 Pet 2:24 ESV) He himself bore our sins in his body on the tree, that we might die to sin and live to righteousness. By his wounds you have been healed.
