- 1. God created us as sexual beings sex is a good thing that we should view as a gift

God's design for sex is only in narriage: 1 man, 1 woman, 4 life

Heb 13:4 Marriage is honorable among all, and the bed undefiled; but fornicators and adulterers God will judge. (NKJV)

Sacred Sex – not self centered

Husbands must connect with their wives emotionally if they expect them to be responsive physically

Wives need to show love to their husbands physically even when they don't feel like it

God's Standard is Purity

Eph 5:3 But among you there must not be even a hint of sexual immorality, or of any kind of impurity, or of greed, because these are improper for God's holy people. 4 Nor should there be obscenity, foolish talk or coarse joking, which are out of place, but rather thanksgiving. 5 For of this you can be sure: No immoral, impure or greedy person-such a man is an idolater-has any inheritance in the kingdom of Christ and of God. 6 Let no one deceive you with empty words, for because of such things God's wrath comes on those who are disobedient. 7 Therefore do not be partners with them.

The message of the culture

- Happiness and fulfillment is found in sex
- Sexual freedom is your right, your reward
- Its all about you getting what you "need"
- The promise of fulfillment coming from sex outside of marriage over promises and under delivers.

Rev 21:3-4a






The Root of Sexual Sin is the neart

The sexual addiction cycle

- 1. We respond to the desire to escape reality through something sexual
- These thoughts capture our attention and we begin the hunt
- We make the connection a magazine, a movie, a website, a person
- 4. We go through with the act
- 5. We feel the letdown and shame
- 6. We vow to never do it again
- We start the cycle over carrying fresh shame

God working in us!

Phil 2:12 Therefore, my dear friends, as you have always obeyed-not only in my presence, but now much more in my absence-continue to work out your salvation with fear and trembling, 13 for it is God who works in you to will and to act according to his good purpose.

A new cycle begins with a new neart

Ezek 11:19 "I will give them an undivided heart and put a new spirit in them; I will remove from them their heart of stone and give them a heart of flesh. 20 Then they will follow my decrees and be careful to keep my laws. They will be my people, and I will be their God. 21 But as for those whose hearts are devoted to their vile images and detestable idols, I will bring down on their own heads what they have done, declares the Sovereign LORD."

The healing process may need to address the past

- Dealing with unforgiveness or bitterness
- Dealing with lies we believe because of something someone did to us
- But we don't want to try and fix our old ways, but learn to walk in new ways

The healing process

- Face the truth of your sin and it's destruction
- Receive God's grace grasp your brokenness
- 3. Put boundaries in place to guide the way
- 4. Learn God's truth about who He is and what His love is like
- 5. Learn to connect with God in true closeness
- Develop open and honest same sex relationships with others

Jesus bore our shame

Heb 13:12 And so Jesus also suffered outside the city gate to make the people holy through his own blood. 13 Let us, then, go to him outside the camp, bearing the disgrace he bore.
