Luke 22:19 (NIV)

And he took bread, gave thanks and broke it, and gave it to them, saying, "This is my body given for you; do this in remembrance of me."

Point : 1

We can get this wrong .

John 10:7 (NIV)

(John 10:7 NIV) Therefore Jesus said again, "I tell you the truth, I am the gate for the sheep."

1 Peter 3:18 (NIV)

For Christ died for sins once for all, the righteous for the unrighteous, to bring you to God. He was put to death in the body but made alive by the Spirit,

1 Cor 11:20-21 (NIV)

(1 Cor 11:20-21 NIV) When you come together, it is not the Lord's Supper you eat, for as you eat, each of you goes ahead without waiting for anybody else. One remains hungry, another gets drunk.

Point : 2

We remember The Lord in
communion.

1 Cor 11:24-25 (NIV)

(1 Cor 11:24-25 NIV) and when he had given thanks, he broke it and said, "This is my body, which is for you; do this in remembrance of me." In the same way, after supper he took the cup, saying, "This cup is the new covenant in my blood; do this, whenever you drink it, in remembrance of me."

Romans 5:7-8 (NIV)

Very rarely will anyone die for a righteous man, though for a good man someone might possibly dare to die. But God demonstrates his own love for us in this: While we were still sinners, Christ died for us.

Point : 3

God will judge the wrongdoer .

1 Cor 11:27 (NIV)

Therefore, whoever eats the bread or drinks the cup of the Lord in an unworthy manner will be guilty of sinning against the body and blood of the Lord.

1 Cor 11:30 (NIV)

That is why many among you are weak and sick, and a number of you have fallen asleep.

Point : 4

We need to judge ourselves.

1 Cor 11:28 (NIV)

A man ought to examine himself before he eats of the bread and drinks of the cup.
