### Don't Fall Away

Heb 6:4-12

4 It is impossible for those who have once been enlightened, who have tasted the heavenly gift, who have shared in the Holy Spirit, 5 who have tasted the goodness of the word of God and the powers of the coming age, 6 if they fall away, to be brought back to repentance, because to their loss they are crucifying the Son of God all over again and subjecting him to public disgrace. 7 Land that drinks in the rain often falling on it and that produces a crop useful to those for whom it is farmed receives the blessing of God.

### Don't Fall Away

Heb 6:4-12

9 Even though we speak like this, dear friends, we are confident of better things in your case — things that accompany salvation. 10 God is not unjust; he will not forget your work and the love you have shown him as you have helped his people and continue to help them. 11 We want each of you to show this same diligence to the very end, in order to make your hope sure. 12 We do not want you to become lazy, but to imitate those who through faith and patience inherit what has been promised.

## Don't Shipwreck

1 Tim 1:18-20

18 Timothy, my son, I give you this instruction in keeping with the prophecies once made about you, so that by following them you may fight the good fight, 19 holding on to faith and a good conscience. Some have rejected these and so have shipwrecked their faith. 20 Among them are Hymenaeus and Alexander, whom I have handed over to Satan to be taught not to blaspheme.

## Principles of Salvation

- Salvation comes by calling upon the name of the Lord - Repentance and Faith
- We are saved by grace through faith:
  Good works, neither before we are saved
  nor after we are saved are what saves us:
- We walk by daily reckoning our old selves as dead and living for Christ
- Our salvation is completed as a work of continuing trust and obedience.

### Deadly Territory

- · A life devoid of good works for Christ
- A life of conscious, continuous rebellion against God's ways
- · An inability to hear God's voice
- · A lack of conviction over known sin

2 Tim 4:6-8

For I am already being poured out like a drink offering, and the time has come for my departure. 7 I have fought the good fight, I have finished the race, I have kept the faith. 8 Now there is in store for me the crown of righteousness, which the Lord, the righteous Judge, will award to me on that day - and not only to me, but also to all who have longed for his appearing.

#### To those who Overcome

- ...a white stone with a new name written on it, known only to him who receives it

- · ... authority over the nations
- Jesus will acknowledge his name before my Father and his angels
- · Will never leave the city of God

- · Will sit with Christ on His throne

#### Press On

Phil 3:12 Not that I have already obtained all this, or have already been made perfect, but I press on to take hold of that for which Christ Jesus took hold of me. 13 Brothers, I do not consider myself yet to have taken hold of it. But one thing I do: Forgetting what is behind and straining toward what is ahead, 14 I press on toward the goal to win the prize for which God has called me heavenward in Christ Jesus.
