What do we know about Moses?

- Born a Hebrew child that was decreed to be killed by the Egyptian Pharaoh (Exodus 1:22)
- Found in the Nile by the Pharaoh's daughter (Exodus 2:6)
- Named "Moses" which means "drawn out of the water." (Exodus 2:10)
- Kills an Egyptian he saw beating a Hebrew, (Ex. 2:11) and flees Egypt.
- Settles in Midian, where he works as a shepherd.
- Sees a burning bush (Ex. 3:1). .

Point : 2

Romans 1:19-20 (NIV)

since what may be known about God is plain to them, because God has made it plain to them. For since the creation of the world God's invisible qualities—his eternal power and divine nature—have been clearly seen, being understood from what has been made, so that men are without excuse.

Romans 1:28 (NIV)

2 Cor 2:14 (NIV)

But thanks be to God, who always leads us in triumphal procession in Christ and through us spreads everywhere the fragrance of the knowledge of him.

Mat 5:16 (NIV)

In the same way, let your light shine before men, that they may see your good deeds and praise your Father in heaven.

2 Th 1:11 (NIV)

With this in mind, we constantly pray for you, that our God may count you worthy of his calling, and that by his power he may fulfill every good purpose of yours and every act prompted by your faith.
