#### Three Events that Set our Trajectory

The resurrection
The ascension
The return

### The Resurrection John 20:1-9, 1 Cor 15:3-8

- 1. We should no longer fear death (Heb 2:14-15)
- 2. We know good triumphs over evil (Col 2:15)
- 3. We will also be resurrected
- 4. We will have a physical existence after our resurrection (1 Cor 15:42-44)

### The Ascension Mt 28:18, Acts 1:3-11

- 1. Jesus was physically alive he wasn't just a ghost.
- 2. Jesus is the ruler over all authorities. (Eph 1:19-23)
- 3. Jesus defeated our enemies (Col 2:15, Mt 12:28, Jn 12:31)
- 4. We can rest in the finished work that Jesus accomplished for us!

(Heb 10:12, Ps 110:1, Acts 7:55)

5. Jesus sent the gifts of the Holy Spirit (Eph 4:7-8)

### The Return Acts 1:11

- 1. He will conquer the final enemy, death (1 Cor 15:24-28)
- 2. He will come to judge the world (Ps 98:9)
- 3. He will usher in a new, physical, uncorrupted kingdom on the earth (Rev 21:1-4)
- 4. Our work in the Lord (now) is not in vain
  - (1 Cor 15:53-58)

Therefore, my dear brothers, stand firm. Let nothing move you. Always give yourselves fully to the work of the Lord, because you know that your labor in the Lord is not in vain.
