Men and Women

Genesis 1:27 So God created man in his own image, in the image of God he created him; male and female he created them.

Poverty...

Children in father-absent homes are five times more likely to be poor.

What can I do?

1.) Keep to God's definition of Marriage

Mal 2:15a Did he not make them one, with a portion of the Spirit in their union?

What Jesus said...

Mark 10:6-9 But from the beginning of creation, 'God made them male and female.' 'Therefore a man shall leave his father and mother and hold fast to his wife, and the two shall become one flesh.' So they are no longer two but one flesh. What therefore God has joined together, let not man separate."

2.) Don't play house before marriage.

Mal 2:14 But you say, "Why does he not?" Because the LORD was witness between you and the wife of your youth, to whom you have been faithless, though she is your companion and your wife by covenant.

The way it should be

1Co 6:12-14 "All things are lawful for me," but not all things are helpful. "All things are lawful for me," but I will not be enslaved by anything.
