Col 3:21 - Jesus' Guidance for Dads

Col 3:21 NIV Fathers, do not **embitter** your children, or they will become **discouraged**.

Eph 6:4 NIV Fathers, do not **exasperate** your children; instead, bring them up in the **training** and **instruction** of the Lord.

In each case he addresses the *Father*

In each case he tells us <u>not to embitter or exasperate</u> our children

In one case he describes the outcome if we do

• They will become discouraged

In the other case he gives instruction about what to do instead

• Bring them up in the training and instruction of the LORD

In each case he addresses the FATHER

- The raising of children is the responsibility of the Father
- This is our accountability before the LORD (you cannot delegate accountability)
 - When Eve sinned the LORD confronted Adam
 - Gen 3:9 NIV But the LORD God called to the man, "Where are you?"
 - Our wives are there to assist but we must lead the way

In each case he tells us not to embitter or exasperate our children

Col 3:21- Embitter - Do not provoke

• Of uncertain affinity; a quarrel, that is, (by implication) wrangling: - contention, debate, strife, variance

Eph 6:4 - Exasperate - Anger

List of 25 Ways to Provoke Anger in Our Children

- Lack of marital harmony
- Establishing and maintaining a child-centered home
- Modeling sinful anger
- Habitually disciplining in anger
- Scolding
- Being inconsistent with discipline
- Having double standards
- Being legalistic
- Not admitting you're wrong and not asking for forgiveness
- Constantly finding fault
- Parents reversing God-given roles
- Not listening to your child's opinion or taking his or her 'side of the story' seriously

- Comparing them to others
- Not making time 'just to talk'
- Not praising or encouraging your child
- Failing to keep your promises
- Chastening in front of others
- Not allowing enough freedom
- Allowing too much freedom
- Mocking your child
- Abusing them physically
- Ridiculing or name calling
- Unrealistic expectations
- Practicing favoritism
- Child training with worldly methodologies inconsistent with God's Word

In one case he describes the outcome if we do exasperate or provoke them

Lest they become DISCOURAGED

- Without passion to be spiritless, that is, disheartened: be dismayed.
- Do not quench the spirit
 - o 1Th 5:19 NIV Do not guench the Spirit.
- Before you were in your mother's womb
 - o Jer 1:5

In the other case he gives instruction about what to do instead

Training - [Strong's] - tutorage, that is, education or training; by implication disciplinary correction: - chastening, chastisement, instruction, nurture.

This includes impartation of Scripture

- 2Ti 3:16-17 NIV All Scripture is God-breathed and is useful for teaching, rebuking, correcting and **training** in righteousness, (17) so that the servant of God may be thoroughly equipped for every good work.
- 2Ti 3:15 NIV and how <u>from infancy</u> you have known the Holy Scriptures, which are able to make you wise for salvation through faith in Christ Jesus.

This includes rebuke and discipline

Heb 12:5-6 NIV And have you completely forgotten this word of encouragement that
addresses you as a father addresses his son? It says, "My son, do not make light of the Lord's
discipline, and do not lose heart when he rebukes you, (6) because the Lord disciplines
the one he loves, and he chastens everyone he accepts as his son."

Instruction

[Strong's] - calling attention to, that is, (by implication) mild rebuke or warning: - admonition.-

Don't Waste Your God-Given Influence

INFLUENCE to affect a HEART for ETERNITY

Pro 17:6 ESV Grandchildren are the crown of the aged, and the glory of children is their fathers.

You have to be willing to have compassion

Psa 103:13-18 NIV As a father has **compassion** on his children, so the LORD has compassion on those who fear him; (14) for he knows how we are formed, he remembers that we are dust.

1Th 2:11-12 NIV For you know that we dealt with each of you as a father deals with his own children, (12) **encouraging**, **comforting** and **urging you to live lives worthy of God**, who calls you into his kingdom and glory.

You have to be willing to bring discipline

Fathers - be willing to bring discipline

Pro 13:24 NIV Whoever spares the rod hates their children, but **the one who loves their children is careful to discipline them.**

Proper discipline can affect your child's heart

Pro 22:15 NIV Folly is bound up in the heart of a child, but the rod of discipline will drive it far away.
