Mat 8:3 [to a man with leprosy] Jesus reached out his hand and touched the man.

2) Or a discharge of any kind

Luk 8:44 She came up behind him and touched the edge of his cloak, and immediately her bleeding stopped.

3) Unclean because of a dead body

Luk 8:54 But he took her by the hand and said, "My child, get up!"

Heb 13:12 And so Jesus also suffered outside the city gate to make the people holy through his own blood.

Vs 6...Any man or woman who wrongs another in any way and so is unfaithful to the LORD is guilty


What About Restitution? If you are the offender


Rom 13:8 Let no debt remain outstanding, except the continuing debt to love one another

The Offering for Jealousy





The Offering for Adulteress caught in the very act (Jn 8:1-11) **Jealousy** They brought the woman to Vs 16 set her before the Jesus (The LORD) LORD Vs 17 take some of the **dust** Jesus wrote in the **dust** (Jn 8) that is on the floor of the tabernacle and put it into the water

The Offering for Jealousy	Adulteress caught in the very act (Jn 8:1-11)
Vs 16 set her before the LORD	They brought the woman to Jesus (The LORD)
Vs 17 take some of the <u>dust</u> that is on the floor of the tabernacle and put it into the water	Jesus wrote in the <u>dust</u> (Jn 8)
Offering of remembrance, - grain offering of jealousy - a remembrance of iniquity	The bread and cup - a remembrance of removing iniquity

Jesus offered water that And in his hand the priest shall springs to everlasting life (Jn have the water of bitterness 4) that brings the curse. He became a curse for us (Gal 3:13)

And in his hand the priest shall have *the water of bitterness* that brings *the curse*.

Jesus offered <u>water that</u>
<u>springs to everlasting life</u> (Jn 4)

He became a curse for us (Gal 3:13)

Then the priest shall make her take an oath...(if no man has lain with you then...but if you have gone astray then...)

write these curses in a book and wash them off into the water of bitterness... make the woman drink the water of bitterness that brings the curse


Shall I not <u>drink the cup</u> the Father has given me? (Jn 18:8)


write these curses in a book and wash them off into the water of bitterness... make the woman drink the water of bitterness that brings the curse
