# Phinehas ... has turned back my wrath (Num 25:11)

#### Jesus did this for us

Rom 5:9 ESV Since, therefore, we have now been justified by his blood, much more shall we be *saved by him from the wrath of God*.

# Phinehas ... was jealous (zeal) (Num 25:11)

# Jesus was stirred by zeal John 2:17 His disciples remembered that it was written, "Zeal for your house will consume me."

# Phinehas ... was given a covenant of PEACE (Num 25:13)

Jesus made peace with God for us Col 1:20 ESV and through him to reconcile to himself all things, whether on earth or in heaven, making peace by the blood of his cross.

# Phinehas ... made atonement for the people of Israel (Num 25:13)

# We have received atonement through Jesus Christ our LORD

Rom 5:11 KJV And not only so, but we also joy in God through our Lord Jesus Christ, by whom we have now received the atonement.

Hos 9:10 ESV Like grapes in the wilderness, I found Israel. Like the first fruit on the fig tree in its first season, I saw your fathers. But they came to Baal-peor and consecrated themselves to the thing of shame, and became detestable like the thing they loved.

Hos 2:16-17 ESV "And in that day, declares the LORD, you will call me 'My Husband,' and no longer will you call me 'My Baal.' 17 For I will remove the names of the Baals from her mouth, and they shall be remembered by name no more.
