1 Corinthians 1:10-17

Baptism - More than an Outward Sign

Christ sent me not to baptize

...he was addressing the issue of division NOT the value of baptism

Act 18:8 ESV Crispus, the ruler of the synagogue, believed in the Lord, together with his entire household. And many of the Corinthians hearing Paul believed and were baptized.

A few things Paul links to baptism

- 1)The idea of FOLLOWING
- 1)Relationship to a NAME
- 1)A tie in to the CROSS



In baptism we identify with a teacher ---"Who Are You Following?"

Mat 28:19-20 ESV Go therefore and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, 20 teaching them to observe all that I have commanded

Luk 11:1 ESV Now Jesus was praying in a certain place, and when he finished, one of his disciples said to him, "Lord, teach us to pray, as John taught his disciples."

Mar 2:18 ESV Now John's disciples and the Pharisees were fasting. And people came and said to him, "Why do John's disciples and the disciples of the Pharisees fast, but your disciples do not fast?"

Luk 5:33 ESV And they said to him, "The disciples of John fast often and offer prayers, and so do the disciples of the Pharisees, but yours eat and drink."

Luk 6:40 ESV A <u>disciple</u> is not above his teacher, but everyone when he is fully trained <u>will be like</u> <u>his teacher</u>.

POWER IN THE NAME OF JESUS

You weren't baptized in Paul's name, you were baptized in the name of Jesus

Mat 28:19 ESV Go therefore and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit

In practice, here is how they did it Acts 2:38-39 The name of Jesus Christ

Acts 8:14-16 The name of the Lord Jesus

Acts 10:48 The name of Jesus Christ

Acts 19:5 The name of the Lord Jesus

Act 3:6 ESV In the name of Jesus Christ of Nazareth, rise up and walk!"

Act 15:26 ESV men who have risked their lives for the name of our Lord Jesus Christ.

Act 16:18 ESV "I command you in the name of Jesus Christ to come out of her."

Act 21:13 ESV I am ready not only to be imprisoned but even to die in Jerusalem for the name of the Lord Jesus."

Act 26:9 ESV "I myself was convinced that I ought to do many things in opposing the name of Jesus of Nazareth.

vs 6 our old self was crucified with him


vs 3 all of us who have been baptized into Christ Jesus were baptized into his death

vs 4 We were buried therefore with him by baptism into death

vs 4 just as Christ was raised from the dead by the glory of the Father, we too might walk in newness of life

Paul emphasized the preaching of the cross

Apart from the cross (death, burial and resurrection) BAPTISM HAS NO MEANING
