Isa 9:3 You have multiplied the nation; you have increased its joy; they rejoice before you as with joy at the harvest, as they are glad when they divide the spoil.

Luke 2:10 And the angel said to them, "Fear not, for behold, I bring you good *news of great joy* that will be for all the people. 11 For unto you is born this day in the city of David a Savior, who is Christ the Lord.

This "joy to the world" is forever linked to the person and work of Jesus Christ

Acts 8:7-8 For unclean spirits, crying out with a loud voice, came out of many who had them, and many who were paralyzed or lame were healed. 8 So there was much joy in that city.

Act 16:31-34 ESV ...the Philipian jailer "rejoiced along with his entire household that he had believed in God."

The Repentance of ONE PERSON causes Great Joy in heaven

Luke 15:7 Just so, I tell you, there will be more joy in heaven over one sinner who repents than over ninety-nine righteous persons who need no repentance.

## God is Happy / Joyful ---

Where He lives is called "the joy of your master"

Matt 25:21 His master said to him, 'Well done, good and faithful servant. You have been faithful over a little; I will set you over much. Enter into the joy of your master.'

Zephaniah 3:17 ESV The LORD your God is in your midst, a mighty one who will save; he will rejoice over you with gladness; he will quiet you by his love; he will exult over you with loud singing.

Gal 5:22-23 ESV But the fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, 23 gentleness, selfcontrol; against such things there is no law.

John 15:10-11 ESV If you keep my commandments, you will abide in my love, just as I have kept my Father's commandments and abide in his love. 11 These things I have spoken to you, that *my joy may be in you*, and that your joy may be full.

## Our joy is full when His Joy is in Us

to the World

Psa 4:6-7 ESV There are many who say, "Who will show us some good? Lift up the light of your face upon us, O LORD!" 7 You have put more joy in my heart than they have when their grain and wine abound.

Hab 3:17-18 ESV Though the fig tree should not blossom, nor fruit be on the vines, the produce of the olive fail and the fields yield no food, the flock be cut off from the fold and there be no herd in the stalls, 18 yet I will rejoice in the LORD; I will take joy in the God of my salvation.

Jas 1:2 ESV Count it all joy, my brothers, when you meet trials of various kinds, KNOWING THIS...

Luk 6:22-23 ESV "Blessed are you when people hate you and when they exclude you and revile you and spurn your name as evil, on account of the Son of Man! 23 Rejoice in that day, and leap for joy, for behold, your reward is great in heaven; for so their fathers did to the prophets.

Has the kingdom of heaven captured your attention - what is your source of joy?

Mat 13:44 ESV "The kingdom of heaven is like treasure hidden in a field, which a man found and covered up. Then in his joy he goes and sells all that he has and buys that field.

Mar 10:21-22 ESV 21 And Jesus, looking at him, loved him, and said to him, "You lack one thing: go, sell all that you have and give to the poor, and you will have treasure in heaven; and come, follow me." 22 Disheartened by the saying, he went away sorrowful, for he had great possessions.

Maybe our JOY needs to be restored?

to the World

Psa 51:12 ESV Restore to me the joy of your salvation, and uphold me with a willing spirit.

Maybe we're searching for joy in the wrong places - or maybe we just need eternal perspective

Luk 10:17-20 ESV The seventy-two returned with joy, saying, "Lord, even the demons are subject to us in your name!" 18 And he said to them... ... do not rejoice in this, that the spirits are subject to you, but rejoice that your names are written in heaven." Maybe we need to spend a little time in prayer

to the World

John 16:24 Until now you have asked nothing in my name. Ask, and you will receive, that your joy may be full.

Maybe we need to take another look at obedience

John 15:10-11 ESV If you keep my commandments, you will abide in my love, just as I have kept my Father's commandments and abide in his love. 11 These things I have spoken to you, that *my joy* may be in you, *and that* your joy may be full.
