Deut 32:3-4 ESV For I will proclaim
the name of the LORD; ascribe
greatness to our God! 4 "The Rock,
his work is perfect, for all his ways
are justice. A God of faithfulness and
without iniquity, just and upright is he.

Acts 15:18 KJV
Known unto God
are all his works
from the beginning of the world.

Joh 4:34 ESV Jesus said to them, "My food is to *do the will* of him who sent me and to *accomplish his work*.

Joh 14:12 ESV "Truly, truly, I say to you, whoever believes in me will also do the works that I do; and greater works than these will he do, because I am going to the Father.

Eph 2:10 ESV For we are his workmanship, created in Christ Jesus for good works, *which God prepared beforehand*, that we should walk in them.
