Ezra 1:1...the LORD stirred up the spirit of Cyrus king of Persia

Ezra 1:5 ... everyone whose spirit God had stirred to go up to rebuild the house of the LORD that is in Jerusalem.

During the time of Haggai - the excitement of rebuilding had come to a stop

God had stirred them once to His purpose, and they had drifted from it

Our purpose must be aligned with God's

They were living at odds to his purpose, how can he bless their labor He presents an alternative to them - this was the original plan and calling

God explains He is the one that is opposing them because "My house lies in ruins"

They chose God's alternative

They chose God's alternative 1) They responded with obedience 2) They feared the LORD

13 Then Haggai, the messenger of the LORD, spoke to the people with the LORD's message, "I am with you, declares the LORD."

14 And the LORD stirred up the spirit of Zerubbabel the son of Shealtiel, governor of Judah, and the spirit of Joshua the son of Jehozadak, the high priest, and the spirit of all the remnant of the people. And they came and worked on the house of the LORD of hosts, their God

Exo 35:21 ESV And they came, everyone whose heart stirred him, and everyone whose spirit moved him, and brought the LORD's contribution to be used for the tent of meeting, and for all its service, and for the holy garments.

Exo 35:26 ESV All the women whose hearts stirred them to use their skill spun the goats' hair.

Exo 36:2 ESV And Moses called Bezalel and Oholiab and every craftsman in whose mind the LORD had put skill, everyone whose heart stirred him up to come to do the work.

Act 17:16 KJV Now while Paul waited for them at Athens, his spirit was stirred in him, when he saw the city wholly given to idolatry.
