Conflicting statements (Wisdom from above does not bring confusion)

- Some say it is a sign of the end, others say it is not the end of the world¹
- God Sent Coronavirus To Make Moms Stay Home With Kids²
- Evangelical pastor claims coronavirus is God's 'death angel' to 'purge a lot of sin'³
- The coronavirus is a Satanic attempt to kill older Christians so socialism can take over in the U.S.⁴
- The Coronavirus is the work of SATAN and a sign the world has 'strayed from God' and claims Christians will be protected from the virus⁵

Will all Christians be protected? Or is it possible some will die? (fear, doubt)

- The 60-year pastor of a Baptist Church in St. James Parish, described as a "big teddy bear" with a passion for Jesus, **died this week from the respiratory illness tied to the novel coronavirus**, his wife said Friday.⁶
- A 60-year-old pastor has become the **first patient with COVID-19 to die in Malaysia** as the country's coronavirus cases climb to the highest in Southeast Asia. **His wife and daughter are also reported to have tested positive**⁷
- Scott Armstrong's world has suddenly become very small. The 48-year-old Lead Pastor of City Church-Eastside in Atlanta is quarantined with COVID-19.⁸
- Georgetown pastor has coronavirus, church says⁹

Should we defy government or are we to submit to governors and kings as unto the LORD?

- A Louisiana **pastor defies a state order** and **holds a church service** with hundreds of people¹⁰
- A pastor in Florida said fears of exposure to COVID-19 was a "demonic spirit," and he encouraged his parishioners to show up to worship and not heed warnings from officials to avoid crowded spaces.¹¹

Is it a lack of faith to take preventative measures or is it using wisdom?

- One pastor says only "sissies" & "pansies" wash their hands to prevent coronavirus --Christians who use hand sanitizer have "fake faith" etc¹²
- Evangelical pastor mocks 'pansies,' won't close church for coronavirus¹³

Does this kind of proclamation bring glory to the God of miracles?

- Tampa pastor who claimed to cure Zika now says he will cure Florida of coronavirus¹⁴ (to date: Florida has 763 cases and has had 12 deaths)¹⁵
- One man was selling toothpaste¹⁶ as a cure
- And a tv evangelist was selling silver solution that he claims kills the virus¹⁷

Three things the LORD spoke to my heart (No Fear - Seek Wisdom - Look for **Opportunity**)

1) This is not a time for fear (when there is fear we make bad decisions) - hide when we should act. act when we should rest, be silent when we should speak, speak when we have nothing to say

- Psa 34:4 ESV I sought the LORD, and he answered me and delivered me from all my fears.
- Seeking the LORD will deal with our fear

2) This is a time to use wisdom - choose carefully those voices you allow to form your thinking and decisions

- Jas 3:13-17 describes two sources of wisdom -
 - Wisdom that is NOT from above jealousy, selfish ambition earthly, unspiritual and demonic - resulting in confusion and vile practices
 - But the wisdom from above --- is first pure, then peaceable, gentle, open to reason, 0 full of mercy and good fruits, impartial and sincere.
- Jas 1:5 ESV If any of you lacks wisdom, let him ask God, who gives generously to all without reproach, and it will be given him.
- Seeking the LORD will give us wisdom

Bottom line is this is a time for us to be in prayer, to be seeking the LORD, both to deal with the fears of our lives AND to gain wisdom --- He wants us to LOOK to HIM

• Psa 34:5 ESV Those who look to him are radiant, and their faces shall never be ashamed.

3) Look for Opportunity --- In Acts 4 there was an opportunity for the church to recoil in fear Act 4:29-35 ESV And now, Lord, look upon their threats and grant to your servants to continue to speak your word with all **boldness**, 30 while you stretch out your hand to heal, and signs and wonders are performed through the name of your holy servant Jesus." 31 And when they had prayed, the place in which they were gathered together was shaken, and they were all filled with the Holy Spirit and continued to speak the word of God with boldness. 32 Now the full number of

-- Rather than becoming protective of their possessions, they gave to the needy...NOT ONE NEEDY PERSON

- 3) Keep in touch with one another
