A Child is Born - What is His Name?

Mat 1:21-23 ESV She will bear a son, and **you shall call his name Jesus**, for he will save his people from their sins." 22 All this took place to fulfill what the Lord had spoken by the prophet: 23 "Behold, the virgin shall conceive and bear a son, **and they shall call his name Immanuel" (which means, God with us).**

- His name is Jesus He was on a mission "to save His people from their sins"
- Which is it? Jesus or Immanuel? (Abe Lincoln called The Great Emancipator)

This is the Incarnation - a word that means God took on flesh

• Joh 1:1-3 & 14 ESV In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and **the Word was God**. 2 He was in the beginning with God. 3 **All things were made through him**, and without him was not any thing made that was made......14 And **the Word became flesh and dwelt among us**...

He came to help us - to deliver fear death, to atone for sin, to help us in temptation

Heb 2:14-18 ESV Since therefore the <u>children share in flesh and blood</u>, he himself likewise <u>partook of the same</u> things, that through death he might destroy the one who has the power of death, that is, the devil, 15 and <u>deliver all those who through fear of death</u> were subject to lifelong slavery. 16 <u>For surely it is not angels that he helps</u>, but he helps the offspring of Abraham. <u>[SLIDE]</u> 17 Therefore he had to be made like his brothers in every respect, so that he might become a merciful and faithful high priest in the service of God, <u>to make propitiation for the sins</u> of the people. 18 For because he himself has suffered when tempted, he is able <u>to help those who are being tempted</u>.

He helped us because He loves us - propitiation - atonement - he satisfied judgment

1Jn 4:9-10 ESV In this the love of God was made manifest among us, that God sent his only Son into the world, so that we might live through him. 10 In this is love, not that we have loved God but that <u>he loved us and sent his Son</u> to be the propitiation for our sins.

Immanuel - MAN born & GOD given fullness of God - incarnation (is CALLED not IS)

- Isa 9:6 For to us <u>a child is BORN, to us a son is GIVEN</u>; and the government shall be upon his shoulder, and <u>his name shall be called</u> Wonderful Counselor, Mighty God, Everlasting Father, Prince of Peace..
- REVIEW SLIDE AFTER VERSE <u>he is NOT</u> the Father or Spirit, but his Name is Called seen me seen the father...he received the spirit without measure (comforter, counselor, advocate)

Yet the Fullness of deity dwells in Jesus - names of Isa correspond to father son spirit

• SLIDE AFTER VERSE Col 2:9-10 ESV For in him the whole fullness of deity dwells bodily, 10 and you have been filled in him, who is the head of all rule and authority.

The Revelation of His name (He is LORD Yahweh, JESUS Savior, CHRIST Messiah)

• SLIDE AFTER VERSE Act 2:36 ESV Let all the house of Israel therefore know for certain that God has made him both Lord and Christ, this Jesus whom you crucified."

<u>The greatest name LORD Jesus Christ - Lordship of the Father, Savior of the world ,</u> <u>Anointing of the Spirit, - the fullness of deity dwells bodily in Jesus to help us</u>

• Php 2:5-11 ESV Have this mind among yourselves, which is yours in Christ Jesus, 6 who, though he was in the **form of God**, did not count equality with God a thing to be grasped, 7 but emptied himself, by taking the **form of a servant**, being born in the likeness of men. 8 And being **found in human form**, he humbled himself by becoming obedient to the point of death, even death on a cross. 9 Therefore God has highly exalted him and **bestowed on him the name that is above every name**, **10 so that at the name of Jesus every knee should bow, in heaven and on earth and under the earth, 11 and every tongue confess that** *Jesus Christ is Lord*, to the glory of God the Father.
