1 Thess 5:23 Now may the God of peace himself sanctify you completely, and may your whole spirit and soul and body be kept blameless at the coming of our Lord Jesus Christ.

Saul rose from the ground, and although his eyes were opened, he saw nothing. So they led him by the hand and brought him into Damascus. And for three days he was without sight, and neither ate nor drank.

Phil 3:4-7 though I myself have reason for confidence in the flesh also. If anyone else thinks he has reason for confidence in the flesh, I have more: **circumcised** on the eighth day, **of the people of Israel**, of the **tribe of Benjamin**, a **Hebrew of Hebrews**; as to the law, a **Pharisee**; as to zeal, a **persecutor of the church**; as to righteousness under the law, **blameless**. But whatever gain I had, I counted as loss for the sake of Christ.

- Solomon married foreign women and his heart was turned from the Lord

1 Kings 11:3-8 And **his wives turned away his heart.** For when Solomon was old his wives turned away his heart after **other gods**, and his heart was **not wholly true to the Lord his God, as was the heart of David his father.** For Solomon went after Ashtoreth the goddess of the Sidonians, and after Milcom the abomination of the Ammonites. So Solomon did what was evil in the sight of the Lord and did not wholly follow the Lord, as David his father had done. Then Solomon built a high place for Chemosh the abomination of Moab, and for Molech the abomination of the Ammonites, on the mountain east of Jerusalem. And so he did for all his foreign wives, who made offerings and sacrificed to their gods.

- After hearing the word of the Lord, Josiah replaced the pagan/secular worldview, with a biblical worldview.

2 Kings 23:3-4 And the king stood by the pillar and **made a covenant** before the Lord, **to walk after the Lord and to keep his commandments and his testimonies and his statutes with all his heart and all his soul**, to perform the words of this covenant that were written in this book. And all **the people joined in the covenant**. And the king commanded Hilkiah the high priest and the priests of the second order and the keepers of the threshold to **bring out of the temple of the Lord all the vessels made for Baal, for Asherah, and for all the host of heaven**. He burned them outside Jerusalem in the fields of the Kidron and carried their ashes to Bethel.
