Matt 4:17 From that time Jesus began to preach, saying, "*Repent*, for the **kingdom of heaven** is at hand."

Mat 5:1-3 ESV Seeing the crowds, he went up on the mountain, and when he sat down, his disciples came to him. 2 And he opened his mouth and taught them, saying: 3 "Blessed are the poor in spirit, for theirs is the kingdom of heaven.

Mat 5:10 "Blessed are those who are persecuted for righteousness' sake, for theirs is the kingdom of heaven. 11 "Blessed are you when others *revile* you and persecute you and utter all kinds of evil against you falsely on my account. 12 Rejoice and be glad, for your reward is great in heaven, for so they persecuted the prophets who were before you.

Matt 5:19 Therefore whoever relaxes one of the least of these commandments and teaches others to do the same will be called least in the kingdom of heaven, but whoever does them and teaches them will be called great in the kingdom of heaven. For I tell you, unless your righteousness exceeds that of the scribes and Pharisees, you will never enter the kingdom of heaven.

Mat 6:10 ESV Your kingdom come, <u>your</u> <u>will be done</u>, on earth **as it is in heaven**.

Mat 7:21 ESV "Not everyone who says to me, 'Lord, Lord,' will **enter the kingdom of heaven**, but <u>the one who does the will of my</u> <u>Father</u> who is in heaven.

Mat 6:25 ESV "Therefore I tell you, do not be anxious about your life, what you will eat or what you will drink, nor about your body, what you will put on. Is not life more than food, and the body more than clothing?

Mat 6:33 ESV But **seek first the kingdom** of God and his righteousness, and <u>all these</u> <u>things will be added to you</u>. The Sermon on the Mount is about kingdom life
