Matt 5:6 Blessed are those who hunger and thirst
for righteousness...for they shall be satisfied

Ecc 1:8 ESV ... **the eye is not satisfied** with seeing, **nor the ear** filled with hearing

Ecc 5:10 ESV He who loves money **will not be satisfied** with money, nor he who loves wealth with his income; this also is vanity.

Ecc 6:7 ESV All the toil of man is for his mouth, **yet his appetite is not satisfied.**

Tit 3:5 ESV he saved us, **not because of works done by us in righteousness**, but according to his own mercy, by the washing of regeneration and renewal of the Holy Spirit,

2Co 5:21 ESV For our sake he made him to be sin who knew no sin, so that in him **we might become the righteousness of God.**

1Ti 6:11 ESV But as for you, O man of God, flee these things. **Pursue righteousness**, godliness, faith, love, steadfastness, gentleness.

2Ti 2:22 ESV So flee youthful passions and **pursue righteousness**, faith, love, and peace, along with those who call on the Lord from a pure heart.

Eph 4:22-24 ESV to put off your old self, which belongs to your former manner of life and is corrupt through deceitful desires, 23 and to be renewed in the spirit of your minds, 24 and to put on the new self, **created after the likeness of God in true righteousness** and holiness.

Rom 6:13 ESV Do not present your members to sin as instruments for unrighteousness, but present yourselves to God as those who have been brought from death to life, and **your members to God as instruments for righteousness.**

2Ti 3:16-17 ESV All Scripture is breathed out by God and profitable for teaching, for reproof, for correction, and **for training in righteousness**,
17 that the man of God may be competent, equipped for every good work.

Joh 6:35 ESV Jesus said to them, "I am the bread of life; whoever comes to me **shall not hunger**, and whoever believes in me **shall never thirst**.

Psa 107:9 ESV For **he satisfies** the longing soul, and the hungry soul he fills with good things.

Pro 21:3 ESV **To do righteousness** and justice
is more acceptable to the LORD than sacrifice.
