- 5 times use <u>Riches</u> (all in first 3 chapters)
- Uses the word <u>Lavished</u> 1:8
- Uses the word <u>Rich</u> 2:4
- Uses the word <u>Heirs</u> 3:6

Background on Ephesus

 Philippians 1:27 Only conduct yourselves in a manner worthy of the gospel of Christ,

Colossians 1:10 so that you will walk in a manner worthy of the Lord,

• 1 Thessalonians 2:12 so that you would walk in a manner worthy of the God who calls you into His own kingdom and glory.

 Matthew 9:13 I have not come to <u>call</u> the righteous but the sinners

• Galatians 1:6 I am amazed that you are so quickly deserting Him who <u>called</u> you by the grace of Christ, for a different gospel,

• 2 Thessalonians 2:14 It was for this He <u>called</u> you through our gospel, that you may obtain the glory of our Lord Jesus Christ.

Romans 12:1-2

Therefore I urge you, brothers and sisters, by the mercies of God, to present your bodies as a living and holy sacrifice, acceptable to God, which is your spiritual service of worship.

1 Peter 1:13

Therefore, prepare your minds for action, keep sober in spirit set your hope completely on the grace to be brought to you at the revelation of Jesus Christ

2 Peter 1:5-7

Ephesians 1:3-14

What Does Heavenly Places In Christ Mean?

- Verse 4 Just as He chose us in Him before the foundation of the world, that we
 would be holy and blameless before Him
- Verse 5 He has predestined us to adoption through Jesus Christ according to the good pleasure of His will, to the praise of the glory of His grace
- Verse 6 He favored us in the Beloved (Christ)
- Verse 7 We have redemption through his blood
- Verses 7 and 8 We have forgiveness of wrongdoings according to the riches of His grace which He lavished on us
- Verse 11 We have obtained an inheritance according to His will who work things according to His plan
- Verses 13 and 14 We were sealed with the Holy Spirit of promise who is the first installment of our inheritance
- Verse 14 We are God's own possession for redemption

- Verse 4 Just as He chose us in Him before the foundation of the world, that we would be holy and blameless before Him
- Verse 5 He has predestined us to adoption through Jesus Christ according to the good pleasure of His will, to the praise of the glory of His grace
- Verse 6 He favored us in the Beloved (Christ)
- Verse 7 We have redemption through His blood

Ephesians 1:18-20

I pray that the eyes of your heart may be enlightened, so that you will know what is the hope of His calling, what are the riches of the glory of His inheritance in the saints, and what is the boundless greatness of His power toward us who believe. These are in accordance with the working of the strength of His might which He brought about in Christ, when He raised Him from the dead and seated Him at His right hand in the heavenly places,

Ephesians 2:4-7

But God, being rich in mercy, because of His great love with which He loved us, even when we were dead in our wrongdoings, made us alive together with Christ (by grace you have been saved), and raised us up with Him, and seated us with Him in the heavenly places in Christ Jesus, so that in the ages to come He might show the boundless riches of His grace in kindness toward us in Christ Jesus.

Ephesians 2:13

But now in Christ Jesus you who previously were far away have been brought near by the blood of Christ.

Ephesians 2:19

So then you are no longer strangers and foreigners, but you are fellow citizens with the saints (hagios – most holy thing, set apart), and are of God's household,

Ephesians 3:6

to be specific, that the Gentiles are fellow heirs and fellow members of the body, and fellow partakers of the promise in Christ Jesus through the gospel,

Ephesians 3:14-21

For this reason I bend my knees before the Father, from whom every family in heaven and on earth derives its name, that He would grant you, according to the riches of His glory, to be strengthened with power through His Spirit in the inner self, so that Christ may dwell in your hearts through faith; and that you, being rooted and grounded in love, may be able to comprehend with all the saints what is the width and length and height and depth, and to know the love of Christ which surpasses knowledge, that you may be filled to all the fullness of God. Now to Him who is able to do far more abundantly beyond all that we ask or think, according to the power that works within us,

to Him be the glory in the church and in Christ Jesus to all generations forever and ever. Amen.
