The Resurrection & the Work of the Holy Spirit - HS Pt 04

The ongoing effect of the resurrection through the ministry of the Holy Spirit

Joh 16:5-7 ESV But now I am going to him who sent me, and none of you asks me, 'Where are you going?' 6
But because I have said these things to you, sorrow has filled your heart. 7 Nevertheless, I tell you the truth:
 <u>it is to your advantage that I go away</u>, for if I do not go away, <u>the Helper will not come to you</u>. But if I
go, I will send him to you.

Our salvation - (68,000 people Born of the Spirit each day) - each validates resurrection

- 1Pe 1:3 ESV ... According to his great mercy, he has caused us to be **born again (born of the Spirit)** to a living hope through the resurrection of Jesus Christ from the dead,
- Joh 7:39 ESV ...as yet the Spirit had not been given, because Jesus was not yet glorified.
- Joh 20:22 ESV ... he breathed on them and said to them, "Receive the Holy Spirit.

He gave the Holy Spirit so the purpose of the resurrection might be spread to all people everywhere

• Luk 24:46-49 ESV and said to them, "Thus it is written, that the Christ should suffer and <u>on the third day</u> <u>rise</u> from the dead, 47 <u>and that</u> repentance and forgiveness of sins should be proclaimed in his name to all nations, beginning from Jerusalem. 48 You are witnesses of these things. 49 And behold, I am sending the promise of my Father upon you. But <u>stay in the city until</u> you are clothed with power from on high."

The newness of life after baptism is possible because of the resurrection

- Romans 6:4 "We were buried therefore with him by baptism into death, in order that, <u>just as Christ was</u>
 <u>raised from the dead</u> by the glory of the Father, we too might walk in newness of life."
- → Baptism is not just an outward sign…there is burial and a rising up in newness of life resurrection

Every time a person is baptized in the Holy Spirit → it is proof of the resurrection & ascension

- Act 2:32-33 ESV <u>This Jesus God raised up</u>, and of that we all are witnesses. 33 Being therefore exalted at the right hand of God, and having received from the Father the promise of the Holy Spirit, <u>he has poured out</u> this that you yourselves are seeing and hearing.
- → 35,000 per day baptized in the Holy Spirit (today 600 million 1 billion by 2050)

When you see a healing or miracle =gift of the holy spirit & proof of the resurrection → He is still alive

Act 4:9-10 ESV if we are being examined today concerning a good deed done to a crippled man, by what
means this man has been healed, 10 let it be known to all of you and to all the people of Israel that by the
name of Jesus Christ of Nazareth, whom you crucified, whom God raised from the dead--by him this
man is standing before you well.

When we live by the Spirit and overcome the flesh → it is the power of the Spirit that raised Jesus

• Rom 8:11-13 ESV <u>If the Spirit of him who raised Jesus from the dead dwells in you</u>, he who raised Christ Jesus from the dead will also give life to your mortal bodies through his Spirit who dwells in you. 12 So then, brothers, we are debtors, not to the flesh, to live according to the flesh. 13 For if you live according to the flesh you will die, but if by the Spirit you put to death the deeds of the body, you will live.

Holy Spirit given to us as a downpayment of the future inheritance → our resurrection & eternal salvation

1Co 15:16-19 ESV For if the dead are not raised, not even Christ has been raised. 17 And <u>if Christ has</u> <u>not been raised</u>, your faith is futile and you are still in your sins. 18 Then those also who have fallen asleep in Christ have perished. 19 If in Christ we have hope in this life only, we are of all people most to be pitied.
