The Fruit of the Spirit - HS Pt 5

Gal 5:22 But the **fruit of the Spirit** is love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, 23 gentleness, self-control; against such things there is no law.

- The Fruit of the Spirit is not a stand-alone teaching → it is taught within a larger context
- Judaizers said Gentile believers must be circumcised and conform to Jewish customs to be saved
- They might ask, "If people are free from the constraints of the law, how will they walk in righteousness?"
 - o Perhaps they thought only the law could constrain the evil tendency of man the works of the flesh
- When you read of the fruit of the Spirit, your first thought might be how do I get more of this into my life?
- This fruit is a byproduct & evidence of life in the Spirit not something we create through human effort

What else does the letter to the Galatians teach about the Holy Spirit (outside of Chapter 5)

- Gal 3:2 Let me ask you only this: Did you receive the Spirit by works of the law or by hearing with faith?
- Gal 3:5 Does he who **supplies** the Spirit to you and works miracles among you do so by works of the law, or by hearing with **faith**--
- Gal 4:6 And because you are sons, <u>God has sent the Spirit of his Son into our hearts</u>, crying, "Abba! Father!"-----[The heir, a child, is like a slave, owning all. God sent his Son to redeem from law & adopt us.]
- Gal 2:20 ESV I have been crucified with Christ. It is no longer I who live, but Christ who lives in me. And the life I now live in the flesh I live by faith in the Son of God, who loved me and gave himself for me.

FOR FREEDOM CHRIST HAS SET US FREE- our freedom is FAITH through Spirit working by LOVE Through the Spirit - FAITH WAITS for righteousness, FAITH WORKS through LOVE (fruit of the spirit)

• Gal 5:1-6 ESV For freedom Christ has set us free; stand firm therefore, and do not submit again to a yoke of slavery. 2 Look: I, Paul, say to you that if you accept circumcision, Christ will be of no advantage to you. 3 I testify again to every man who accepts circumcision that he is obligated to keep the whole law. 4 You are severed from Christ, you who would be justified by the law; you have fallen away from grace. //// 5 For through the Spirit, by faith, we ourselves eagerly wait for the hope of righteousness. 6 For in Christ Jesus neither circumcision nor uncircumcision counts for anything, but only faith working through love.

CALLED TO FREEDOM, not as an opportunity for the flesh ightarrow fulfill the intent of the law with LOVE (fruit)

13 For you were called to freedom, brothers. Only do not use your freedom as an opportunity for the
flesh, but through LOVE serve one another. 14 For the whole law is fulfilled in one word: "You shall
LOVE your neighbor as yourself."

How to constrain the work of the flesh (recognize there are desires of flesh and desires of the Holy Spirit)

16 But I say, WALK BY THE SPIRIT, and you will not gratify the desires of the flesh. 17 For the desires of the
flesh are against the Spirit, and the desires of the Spirit are against the flesh, for these are opposed to each
other, to keep you from doing the things you want to do. 18 But if you are LED BY THE SPIRIT, you are not
under the law. ----- the law shows us our sin --- a schoolmaster leading to Christ --- led by spirit - better than law

The Desires of My Flesh lead here - called the works (plural) of the flesh

19 Now the works of the flesh are evident: sexual immorality, impurity, sensuality, 20 idolatry, sorcery, enmity, strife, jealousy, fits of anger, rivalries, dissensions, divisions, 21 envy, drunkenness, orgies, and things like these. I warn you, as I warned you before, that those who do such things will not inherit the kingdom of God.

The Desires of the Holy Spirit lead me here -- FRUIT singular - perhaps all are aspects of LOV 22 But the fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, 23 gentleness, self-control; against such things there is no law. 24 And those who belong to Christ Jesus have crucified the flesh with its passions and desires. 25 If we LIVE BY THE SPIRIT, let us also KEEP IN STEP WITH THE SPIRIT.

- Gal 6:8 For the one who sows to his own flesh will from the flesh reap corruption, but the one who SOWS TO THE SPIRIT will from the Spirit reap eternal life.
- Walk by the Spirit, Be led by the Spirit, Live by the Spirit, Keep in step with the Spirit, Sow to the Spirit
