### James---Background, timing and context book was written in

- Acts 8:1 Now Saul was consenting to his death.
- At that time a great persecution arose against the church which was at Jerusalem; and they were all scattered throughout the regions of Judea and Samaria, except the apostles. <sup>2</sup> And devout men carried Stephen to his burial, and made great lamentation over him.
- <sup>3</sup> As for Saul, he made havoc of the church, entering every house, and dragging off men and women, committing *them* to prison.

### James the brother of Jesus / Church leader

- <sup>1 Cor 15:3</sup> For I delivered to you first of all that which I also received: that Christ died for our sins according to the Scriptures, <sup>4</sup> and that He was buried, and that He rose again the third day according to the Scriptures,
- 5 and that He was seen by [a]Cephas, then by the twelve.
- 6 After that He was seen by over five hundred brethren at once, of whom the greater part remain to the present, but some have [b] fallen asleep.
- After that He was seen by James, then by all the apostles

### Direct Approach-- hard hitting style

- James is straightforward in his instructions and admonitions.
- He doesn't use elaborate theological arguments but instead focuses on practical advice and moral imperatives.
- This directness makes his message very accessible but also quite forceful.

### Insight number one –receiving the word

- <sup>19</sup> Know this, my beloved brothers: let every person be quick to hear, slow to speak, slow to anger; <sup>20</sup> for the anger of man does not produce the righteousness of God.
- <sup>21</sup> Therefore put away all filthiness and rampant wickedness and receive with meekness the implanted word, which is able to save your souls. James 1:19-21


### Ready to receive—soil of heart cleared

- ARC======Acknowledge, Confess, Repent
- <sup>7</sup> But if we walk in the light, as he is in the light, we have fellowship with one another, and the blood of Jesus his Son cleanses us from all sin. <sup>8</sup> If we say we have no sin, we deceive ourselves, and the truth is not in us. <sup>9</sup> If we confess our sins, he is faithful and just to forgive us our sins and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness. <sup>10</sup> If we say we have not sinned, we make him a liar, and his word is not in us.

### Psalm 51

- Have mercy upon me, O God,
   According to Your lovingkindness;
   According to the multitude of Your tender mercies,
   Blot out my transgressions.

   Wash me thoroughly from my iniquity,
   And cleanse me from my sin.
- <sup>3</sup> For I acknowledge my transgressions, And my sin *is* always before me. <sup>4</sup> Against You, You only, have I sinned, And done *this* evil in Your sight— That You may be found just [a] when You speak, *And* blameless when You judge.

- Behold, I was brought forth in iniquity,
   And in sin my mother conceived me.
   Behold, You desire truth in the inward parts,

### Not being calloused by sins

- Hebrews 3:12-14
- <sup>2</sup> Beware, brethren, lest there be in any of you an evil heart of unbelief in departing from the living God; <sup>13</sup> but exhort one another daily, while it is called "Today," lest any of you be hardened through the deceitfulness of sin. <sup>14</sup> For we have become partakers of Christ if we hold the beginning of our confidence steadfast to the end, <sup>15</sup> while it is said:
- •"Today, if you will hear His voice, Do not harden your hearts as in the rebellion."

# 2<sup>nd</sup> insight for this year – Changed perspective

- 2 Corinthian 5:11, 14-16
- <sup>11</sup> Knowing, therefore, the terror of the Lord, we persuade men; but we are well known to God, and I also trust are well known in your consciences.....
- <sup>14</sup> For the love of Christ compels us, because we judge thus: that if One died for all, then all died; <sup>15</sup> and He died for all, that those who live should live no longer for themselves, but for Him who died for them and rose again.
- <sup>16</sup> Therefore, from now on, we regard no one according to the flesh. Even though we have known Christ according to the flesh, yet now we know *Him thus* no longer.
