The church is the body of Christ - this analogy has to do with every member functioning in unique ways

 1Pe 4:10-11 ESV As each has received a gift, use it to serve one another, as good stewards of <u>God's varied grace</u>: 11 whoever speaks, as one who speaks oracles of God; whoever serves, as one who serves by the strength that God supplies--in order that <u>in everything God may be glorified</u> through Jesus Christ. To him belong glory and dominion forever and ever. Amen.

There is something called good works that also glorify Him

• Mat 5:16 ESV In the same way, let your light shine before others, so that they may see your <u>good</u> <u>works and give glory to your Father</u> who is in heaven.

God has prepared beforehand good works \Rightarrow we should walk in them

• Ephesians 2:10 (ESV) For we are his workmanship, created in Christ Jesus for **good works**, which God **prepared beforehand**, that **we should walk in them**.

Mindset

What we do to others we do to Jesus

Mat 25:35-36 & 40 ESV For I was hungry and you gave me food, I was thirsty and you gave me drink, I was a stranger and you welcomed me, 36 I was naked and you clothed me, I was sick and you visited me, I was in prison and you came to me.'.....And the King will answer them, 'Truly, I say to you, as you did it to one of the least of these my brothers, you did it to me.'

Serve your way into a reputation (reputation = your life becomes your testimony)

- 1 Tim 5:10 ESV...having a reputation for good works: if she has brought up children, has shown hospitality, has washed the feet of the saints, has cared for the afflicted, and has devoted herself to every good work
- **Dorcas made tunics and garments** Act 9:36-39 ESV ...a disciple named Tabitha, or Dorcas died...She was *full of good works and acts of charity*...All the widows stood beside him weeping and showing **tunics** and other **garments** that Dorcas made while she was with them.

Find a need and fill it

- **Cup of cold water** Mat 10:42 ESV And whoever gives one of these little ones even a cup of cold water because he is a disciple, truly, I say to you, he will by no means lose his reward."
- Aquila and Priscilla helped Paul with a job and get established Act 18:3 ESV3 and <u>because</u> <u>he was of the same trade he stayed with them and worked, for they were tentmakers by trade.</u>
- Good Samaritan Luke 10:29 "Who is my neighbor?" \rightarrow go and do likewise

Practical Steps

Prayer and a WILLING heart \rightarrow Word of Knowledge, Working of Miracles or Healing - Paul was healed, baptized in water and filled with Holy Spirit

Act 9:10-17 ESV Now there was a disciple at Damascus named Ananias. The Lord said to him in a vision, "Ananias." And he said, "Here I am, Lord." <u>..... 13 But Ananias answered, "Lord, I have heard from many about this man, how much evil he has done to your saints at Jerusalem. 15 But the Lord said to him, "Go, for he is a chosen instrument of mine17 So Ananias departed and entered the house.
</u>

Take Someone Under Your Wing

• Act 9:27 ESV But Barnabas *took him and brought him* to the apostles

• Act 18:26 ESV [Apollos] began to speak boldly in the synagogue, but <u>when Priscilla and Aquila heard</u> <u>him, they took him aside and explained to him the way of God more accurately.</u>

A & P also opened their home for the church to gather (tents with Paul, discipled Apollos)

- 1Co 16:19 ESV...Aquila and Prisca, together with the church in their house, send you hearty greetings in the Lord.
- Rom 16:3-5 ESV Greet Prisca and Aquila.....5 Greet also the church in their house

NT Churches in Homes (Rome, Ephesus, Laodicea, Colossae, Jerusalem, Philippi, Thessalonica, Corinth

NT a vibrant community - created both inside the temple and outside in homes and community

• Act 2:44-47 ESV And all who believed were together and had all things in common. 45 And they were selling their possessions and belongings and **distributing the proceeds to all, as any had need.** 46 And day by day, **attending the temple** together and **breaking bread** in their homes, they received their food with glad and generous hearts, 47 **praising God** and having **favor with all the people**. And the **Lord added** to their number day by day **those who were being saved**.
