2 Let us come into his presence with thanksgiving

let us make a joyful noise to him with songs of praise! 3 For the LORD is a great God, and a great King above all

gods.

4 <u>In his hand</u> are the <u>depths</u> of the earth; the <u>heights</u> of the mountains are his also.

5 The <u>sea</u> is his, for <u>he made it</u>, and his <u>hands</u> formed the <u>dry land</u>.

6 Oh come, <u>let us worship</u> and bow down; <u>let us kneel</u> before the LORD, <u>our Maker</u>!

<u>Today</u>, *if you hear his voice*, 8 <u>do not</u> <u>harden your hearts</u>, as at Meribah, as on the day at Massah in the wilderness, 9 when your fathers put me to the test and put me to the proof, though they had seen my work.
