Psa 103:1-22 ESV Of David. Bless the LORD, O my soul, and all that is within me, bless his holy name!

- Focus on 3 things -- <u>BLESS</u> → <u>MY SOUL</u> → <u>HIS HOLY NAME</u>
- The psalm begins (v1) and ends (v22) with "Bless the Lord O my soul"

BLESS = to kneel - to show adoration - closely related to praise

• Psa 34:1 I will bless the LORD at all times; his praise shall continually be in my mouth.

$\underline{MY \ SOUL} \rightarrow$ and all that is within me David is talking to his soul (<u>draw near with lips heart far</u>)

Why we need to talk to the soul (mind, will, emotions) interacts with and can be (-/+) affected by LIFE

- Psa 6:3 My soul also is greatly troubled
- Psa 31:9-10 My soul and my body also are wasted from grief
- Psa 119:28 My soul melts away for sorrow
- 2Pe 2:8 Lot's righteous soul was tormented in Sodom

SLIDE

• Psa 42:5 Why are you cast down, O my soul, and why are you in turmoil within me? Hope in God

<u>BLESS HIS HOLY NAME</u> it is hope in God that lifts our soul - this psalm a reminder of God & benefits **In the Hebrew language** → connection between a person and their name. **To "be called" something** was understood as **"to be" that thing -- Examples**

- Mat 1:21 ESV She will bear a son, and you shall call his name Jesus, for he will save his people from their sins."
- Gen 17:5 ESV No longer shall your name be called Abram [FATHER], but your **name shall be** Abraham [FATHER OF A MULTITUDE], **for I have made you** the father of a multitude of nations.

This is also true with God - His many names reveal who He is or what He does - Examples

- Jehovah-Jireh (The LORD Will Provide) Gen 22:14
- Jehovah-Rapha (The LORD Who Heals) Ex 15:26
- Jehovah-Nissi (The LORD Is My Banner) Ex 17:15
- Jehovah-Shalom (The LORD Is Peace) Jud 6:24
- Jehovah-Raah (The LORD Is My Shepherd) Ps 23:1
- Jehovah-Tsidkenu (The LORD Our Righteousness) Jer 23:6
- Jehovah-Shammah (The LORD Is There) Ezek 48:35

Moses "SHOW ME YOUR GLORY" - God linked His name to His glory and his goodness

Exo 33:18-19 ESV Moses said, "Please show me your glory." 19 And he said, "I will make all my goodness pass before you and will proclaim before you my name 'The LORD.' And I will be gracious to whom I will be gracious, and will show mercy on whom I will show mercy.

WHEN HE ACTUALLY PROCLAIMED HIS NAME TO MOSES

Exo 34:5-6 ESV The LORD descended in the cloud and stood with him there, and proclaimed the
name of the LORD. 6 The LORD passed before him and proclaimed, "The LORD, the LORD, a God
merciful and gracious, slow to anger, and abounding in steadfast love and faithfulness,

DAVID REFERENCED THIS - AND IT IS WHAT HE MEANT BY SAYING <u>BLESS HIS HOLY NAME</u>
Psa 103:7 He made known his ways to Moses, his acts to the people of Israel. 8 The LORD is merciful and gracious, slow to anger and abounding in steadfast love.

David refers to this event - God reveals his glory & makes his way known through revealing His name

Merciful - compassionate

Gracious - to bend or stoop in kindness to an inferior

Slow to Anger - patient, long suffering

Steadfast Love - Chesed - the word that can't be described in English - a cup trying to catch a waterfall

How can we step into BLESS THE LORD?

REMEMBER HIS BENEFITS → these are all expressions of his name --

AND ALL THAT IS WITHIN ME "BLESS HIS HOLY NAME"

V2 Bless the LORD, O my soul, and forget not all his benefits,

- -v3 who forgives all your iniquity, who heals all your diseases,
- -v4 who redeems your life from the pit, who crowns you with steadfast love and mercy,
- -v5 who satisfies you with good so that your youth is renewed like the eagle's.
- -v6 The LORD works righteousness and justice for all who are oppressed.
- -v9 He will not always chide, nor will he keep his **anger** forever.
- -v10 He does not deal with us according to our sins, nor repay us according to our iniquities.
- -v11 For as high as the heavens are above the earth, so great is his **steadfast love** toward those who fear him;
- -v12 as far as the east is from the west, so far does he remove our transgressions from us.
- -v13 **As a father shows compassion** to his children, so the LORD shows compassion to those who fear him.

REMEMBER HIS ETERNAL NATURE AND THE EXTENT AND REACH OF HIS KINGDOM

The frailty and temporal nature of man

14 For he knows our frame; he remembers that we are dust. 15 As for man, his days are like grass; he flourishes like a flower of the field; 16 for the wind passes over it, and it is gone, and its place knows it no more.

The continuance and covenant nature of God - generation to generation

 17 But the steadfast love of the LORD is from everlasting to everlasting on those who fear him, and his righteousness to children's children, 18 to those who keep his covenant and remember to do his commandments.

The extent and reach of His kingdom

19 The LORD has established his throne in the heavens, and his kingdom rules over all.

EVERYONE and EVERYTHING \rightarrow BLESS THE LORD

20 Bless the LORD, O you his angels, you mighty ones who do his word, obeying the voice of his word!
 21 Bless the LORD, all his hosts, his ministers, who do his will!
 22 Bless the LORD, all his works, in all places of his dominion. Bless the LORD, O my soul!
