FIRST VERSE Psa 103:1 Of David. Bless the LORD, O my soul, and all that is within me, bless his holy name!

LAST VERSE Psa 103:22 **Bless** the LORD, O my **soul** Psa 34:1 I will <u>bless</u> the LORD at all times; <u>his praise</u> shall continually be in my mouth.

- > Psa 6:3 My **soul** also is greatly **troubled**
- > Psa 31:9-10 My soul and my body also are wasted from grief
- Psa 119:28 My <u>soul</u> melts away for <u>sorrow</u>

Remember His Benefits - the Glory of His Name

- -v2 Bless the LORD, O my soul, and forget not all his benefits,
- -v3 who **forgives** all your **iniquity**, who **heals** all your **diseases**,
- -v4 who **redeems** your life from the **pit**, who **crowns** you with **steadfast love** and **mercy**,
- -v5 who **satisfies** you with **good** so that your **youth** is **renewed** like the eagle's.

- -v6 The LORD works **righteousness** and justice for all who are **oppressed**.
- -v9 He will **not always chide**, nor will he keep his **anger forever**.
- -v10 He does not deal with us **according to our sins**, nor repay us according to our iniquities.
- -v11 For **as high as** the heavens are above the earth, **so great is** his steadfast love toward those who fear him;

- -v12 **as far as** the east is from the west, **so far does** he remove our transgressions from us.
- -v13 **As a father** shows compassion to his children, **so the LORD** shows compassion to those who fear him.

14 For he knows our frame; he remembers that we are dust. 15 As for man, his days are like grass; he flourishes like a flower of the field; 16 for the wind passes over it, and it is gone, and its place knows it no more.

17 But the **steadfast love** of the LORD is from everlasting to everlasting on those who *fear* him, and his righteousness to children's children, 18 to those who keep his covenant and remember to do his commandments.

19 The LORD has established his throne in the heavens, and his kingdom rules over all.

20 Bless the LORD, O you his angels, you mighty ones who do his word, obeying the voice of his word! 21 Bless the LORD, all his hosts, his ministers, who do his will! 22 Bless the LORD, all his works, in all places of his dominion. Bless the LORD, O my soul!
