FIRST VERSE

Psa 103:1 Of David. **Bless** the LORD, O my **soul**, and all that is within me, bless his **holy name!**

LAST VERSE

Psa 103:22 **Bless** the LORD, O my **soul**

*Psa 34:1 I will **bless** the LORD at all times; **his praise** shall continually be in my mouth.*

- *Psa 6:3 - My soul also is greatly troubled*
- *Psa 31:9-10 - My soul and my body also are wasted from grief*
- *Psa 119:28 - My soul melts away for sorrow*
- *2Pe 2:8 - Lot's righteous soul was tormented in Sodom*

Psa 42:5 Why are you cast down, O my soul, and why are you in turmoil within me? Hope in God

Exo 33:18-19 Moses said, "**Please show me your glory.**" 19 And he said, "I will make all **my goodness** pass before you and **will proclaim before you my name** 'The LORD.' And I will be gracious to whom I will be gracious, and will show mercy on whom I will show mercy.

Exo 34:5-6 The LORD descended in the cloud and stood with him there, and **proclaimed the name of the LORD**. 6 The LORD passed before him and **proclaimed**, "The LORD, the LORD, a God merciful and gracious, slow to anger, and abounding in steadfast love and faithfulness..."

David Referenced This Name in v7

Psa 103:7 He made known his ways to Moses, his acts to the people of Israel. 8 The **LORD is merciful and gracious, slow to anger and abounding in steadfast love.**

Remember His Benefits - the Glory of His Name

-v2 Bless the LORD, O my soul, and forget not all his benefits,

-v3 who **forgives** all your **iniquity**, who **heals** all your **diseases**,

-v4 who **redeems** your life from the **pit**, who **crowns** you with **steadfast love** and **mercy**,

-v5 who **satisfies** you with **good** so that your **youth** is **renewed** like the eagle's.

-v6 The LORD works **righteousness** and justice for all who are **oppressed**.

-v9 He will **not always chide**, nor will he keep his **anger forever**.

-v10 He does not deal with us **according to our sins**, nor repay us according to our iniquities.

-v11 For **as high as** the heavens are above the earth, **so great is** his steadfast love toward those who fear him;

-v12 **as far as** the east is from the west,
so far does he remove our
transgressions from us.

-v13 **As a father** shows compassion to
his children, **so the LORD** shows
compassion to those who fear him.

14 For he knows our frame; he remembers that we are **dust**. 15 As for man, his days are like **grass**; he flourishes like a flower of the field; 16 for the wind passes over it, and it is **gone**, and its place knows it **no more**.

17 But the **steadfast love** of the LORD is from **everlasting to everlasting** on those who fear him, and his righteousness to **children's children**, 18 to those who keep his covenant and remember to do his commandments.

19 The LORD has established his throne in the heavens, and **his kingdom rules over all.**

20 Bless the LORD, O you his **angels**, you **mighty ones** who do his word, obeying the voice of his word! 21 Bless the LORD, **all his hosts**, his **ministers**, who do his will! 22 Bless the LORD, **all his works**, in all places of his dominion. **Bless the LORD, O my soul!**
