Ps 119 is the longest chapter in the bible - George Wishart & Scaffold: Ps 119 saved his life

• 22 stanzas of 8 vs each - vs in each stanza start with letters of the alphabet (1-8 "A"), (9-16 "B")

One of 9 words is used in all by 5 verses explaining various ways God has chosen to reveal His will to man

• Law (25x) Testimony (23x) Way (13x) Precepts (21x) Statutes (21x) Commandment (22x) Judgments (23x) Word (24x) Word (19x) -- (all 9 are used in the 1st 16 vs covered today)

### The pivotal verse (God has spoken → How will we respond? - He commands we keep)

Ps 119:4 You have commanded your precepts to be kept diligently.

- God command us to keep (guard with hedge of thorns) diligently (stir hot coals)
- His Precepts practical application of God's will for <u>daily living</u> → it will impact every aspect of our life
- Why? GOD DESIRES THAT OUR LIVES BE BLESSED

## Secret of a Blessed Life - Keeping Precepts, our way of life→ "generic message to all"

Ps 119:1-3 **Blessed** are <u>those whose way is blameless</u>, who <u>walk</u> in the law of the LORD! 2 Blessed are those who <u>keep</u> his testimonies, who <u>seek</u> him with their whole heart, 3 who also <u>do no wrong</u>, but <u>walk</u> <u>in his</u> ways!

- We are **BLESSED** when our **WAY** is BLAMELESS (way is a road, a course of life or mode of action)
- It is described as BLAMELESS because we WALK IN HIS WAYS
- Our WAY becomes HIS WAY
  - Psa 18:30-32 ESV This God--his way is perfect...32 the God who equipped me with strength and made my way blameless. [perfect and blameless same word in Hebrew]
- Keep it diligently HOW? (intentionality → walk, keep, seek, do no wrong, walk in HIS ways)

# From Generic "those whose way" to personal "O that my ways" (I, me, my is used 20x) Begins with desire to align your life with His way [strong enough to FIX my eyes]

• 5 Oh that my ways may be steadfast in keeping your statutes! 6 Then I shall not be put to shame, having my eyes fixed on all your commandments.

#### Desire must give way to learning and keeping - This has a direct impact on MY WAY

• 7 <u>I will praise</u> you with an upright heart, <u>when I learn</u> your righteous <u>rules</u>. 8 <u>I will keep</u> your <u>statutes</u>; do not utterly forsake me! 9 How can a young man <u>keep his way pure</u>? By guarding it according to your <u>word</u>. 10 With my whole heart <u>I seek you; let me not wander</u> from your <u>commandments</u>! 11 I <u>have stored</u> up your <u>word</u> in my heart, that I might not sin against you. 12 Blessed are you, O LORD; teach me your statutes!

#### Learning leads to affection and joy

13 With my lips <u>I declare</u> all the rules of your mouth. 14 In the way of your testimonies <u>I delight as much as in all riches</u>. 15 <u>I will meditate</u> on your precepts and <u>fix my eyes on your ways.</u> 16 <u>I will delight</u> in your statutes; I <u>will not forget</u> your word.

I talk about it, delight in it, think about it, fix my eyes on HIS WAYS, do not forget about
