Human Conflict - a result of the Fall

Before the fall:

Adam and Eve were "one flesh" (Gen 2:24)

After the fall:

There was a struggle for control

Gen 3:16 "Your desire shall be for your husband, and he shall rule over you."

Eph 5:21-23 ESV submitting to one another out of reverence for Christ. 22 Wives, submit to your own husbands, as to the Lord. 23 For the husband is the head of the wife even as Christ is the head of the church, his body, and is himself its Savior.

Matthew 5:23-24 So if you are offering your gift at the altar and there remember that your brother has something against you, leave your gift there before the altar and go. **First be reconciled** to your brother, and then come and offer your gift. Rom 12:17-18 Repay no one evil for evil, but give thought to do what is **honorable** in the sight of all. 18 If possible, **so far as it depends on you**, live peaceably with all.

Pro 17:14 The beginning of strife is like letting out water, so quit before the quarrel breaks out.

1Co 6:7 ESV To have lawsuits at all with one another is already a defeat for you. Why not rather suffer wrong? Why not rather be defrauded?

Pro 19:11 Good sense makes one slow to anger, and it is his glory to overlook an offense.

Prov 17:9 Whoever **covers** an offense seeks love, but he who repeats a matter **separates** close friends.

Mat 7:5 first take the log out of your own eye, and then you will see clearly to take the speck out of your brother's eye.

Jas 1:19 let every person be quick to hear, slow to speak, slow to anger;

Prov 15:31 The ear that listens to life-giving reproof will dwell among the wise.

Prov 15:1 A **soft answer** turns away wrath, but a harsh word stirs up anger.

Eph 4:32 Be kind to one another, tenderhearted, forgiving one another, as God in Christ forgave you.

Prov 20:22 Do not say, 'I will repay evil'; wait for the Lord, and he will deliver you.

Rom 12:17-21 Repay no one evil for evil, but give thought to do what is **honorable** in the sight of all. 18 If possible, so far as it depends on you, live peaceably with all. 19 Beloved, never avenge yourselves, but leave it to the wrath of God, for it is written, "Vengeance is mine, I will repay, says the Lord."

20 To the contrary, "if your enemy is hungry, feed him; if he is thirsty, give him something to drink; for by so doing you will heap burning coals on his head." 21 Do not be overcome by evil, but overcome evil with good.
