Dying to Self

²³ And he said to all, "If anyone would come after me, let him deny himself and take up his cross daily and follow me.

Romans 6:6-7 ESV

⁶ We know that our <u>old self</u>^[a] was crucified with him in order that the body of sin might be brought to nothing, so that we would no longer be enslaved to sin. ⁷ For one who has died has <u>been set free</u>^[b] from sin.

2 Timothy 3:1-2 ESV

3 But understand this, that in the <u>last days</u> there will come times of difficulty. ² For people will be <u>lovers of self</u>, lovers of money, proud, arrogant, abusive, disobedient to their parents, ungrateful, unholy,

Point 1. What is the old self / old man.

1 Corinthians 2:14 ESV

¹⁴ The <u>natural person does **not accept** the things of the Spirit of God</u>, for they are folly to him, and he is not able to understand them because they are spiritually discerned.

AMPLIFIED

¹⁴ But the natural [unbelieving] man does not accept the things [the teachings and revelations] of the Spirit of God, for they are foolishness [absurd and illogical] to him; and he is incapable of understanding them, because they are spiritually discerned *and* appreciated, [and he is unqualified to judge spiritual matters].

The old man lives by the <u>flesh</u>.

Matthew 15:18-20 ESV

¹⁸ But what comes out of the mouth proceeds from the heart, and this defiles a person. ¹⁹ For out of the heart come <u>evil thoughts</u>, <u>murder</u>, <u>adultery</u>, <u>sexual immorality</u>, <u>theft</u>, <u>false</u> witness</u>, <u>slander</u>. ²⁰ These are what defile a person. But to eat with unwashed hands does not defile anyone."

1 Corinthians 3: 3 NKJV

³ for you are still carnal. For where there are envy, strife, and divisions among you, are you not carnal and ^[a]behaving like *mere* men?

Mark 7:21-23 ESV

²¹ For from within, out of the heart of man, come evil thoughts, sexual immorality, theft, murder, adultery, ²² coveting, wickedness, deceit, sensuality, envy, slander, pride, foolishness. ²³ All these evil things come from within, and they defile a person."

Jeremiah 17:9 ESV

⁹ The heart is <u>deceitful above all things</u>, and <u>desperately sick</u>; who can understand it?

Point 2. Why do we need to die to ourselves.

Galatians 2:20 ESV

²⁰ I have been <u>crucified with Christ</u>. It is no longer I who live, <u>but Christ who lives in me</u>. And the life I now live in the flesh I live by faith in the Son of God, who loved me and gave himself for me.

John 12:24-26 ESV

²⁴ Truly, truly, I say to you, unless a grain of wheat falls into the earth and dies, it <u>remains</u> <u>alone</u>; but if it dies, it <u>bears much fruit</u>. ²⁵ Whoever loves his life loses it, and whoever hates his life in this world will keep it for eternal life. ²⁶ If anyone serves me, he must follow me; and where I am, there will my servant be also. If anyone serves me, <u>the Father will honor</u> <u>him</u>.

Romans 12:1 ESV

12 I appeal to you therefore, brothers,^[a] by the mercies of God, to present your bodies as a **living sacrifice**, holy and acceptable to God, which is your <u>spiritual worship</u>.^[b]

Point 3. How to strengthen the spiritual man.

³³ But <u>seek first the kingdom of God</u> and his righteousness, and all these things will be added to you.

Ephesians 5:17 ESV

¹⁷ Therefore do not be foolish but <u>understand what the will of the Lord is</u>.
