## Glad He Sees the Sinner...



1Ti 1:15-16 NLT This is a trustworthy saying, and everyone should accept it: "Christ Jesus came into the world to save sinners"—and I am the worst of them all. 16 But God had mercy on me so that Christ Jesus could use me as a prime example of his great patience with even the worst sinners. Then others will realize that they, too, can believe in him and receive eternal life

1Co 15:1-6 ESV Now I would remind you, brothers, of the gospel I <u>preached</u> to you, which you <u>received</u>, in which you stand, 2 and by which <u>you are being saved</u>, if you <u>hold fast</u> to the word I <u>preached</u> to you--unless you <u>believed</u> in vain. 3 For I delivered to you as of first importance what I also received:

that **Christ died for our sins** in accordance with the Scriptures, 4 that he was buried, that he was raised on the third day in accordance with the Scriptures, 5 and that he appeared to Cephas, then to the twelve. 6 Then he appeared to more than five hundred brothers at one time, most of whom are still alive, though some have fallen asleep.

Rom 6:23 – For the <u>wages</u> of <u>sin</u> is <u>death</u>, but the free gift of God is eternal life in Christ Jesus our Lord.

2 Cor 5:21 – "For our sake he made him to be sin who knew no sin, so that in him we might become the righteousness of God."

Rom 4:24-25 ESV [righteousness] will be counted to us who believe in him who raised from the dead Jesus our Lord, 25 who was delivered up for our trespasses and raised for our justification.

1 Cor 15:17 – "And if Christ has not been raised, your faith is futile and you are still in your sins."

John 11:25–26 – "I am the resurrection and the life...Do you believe this?"

John 1:12 says: But to all who did <u>receive</u> him, who <u>believed</u> in his name, he gave the right to become <u>children of God.</u>
