Becoming the Person God Sees - Judges Pt 6

Gideon is a story where God takes a man full of fear and raises him up to defeat an army of 135,000 w/ 300

Jdg 6:1 The people of Israel did what was evil in the sight of the LORD (7 yrs Midianites stole food, starvation)

• Vs 6 ... And the people of Israel <u>cried out for help to the LORD</u>.

A cry for the LORD's help → Opens the Door to His Involvement → leads to Mercy & Accountability

- GOD IS MERCIFUL → 7 When the people of Israel cried out to the LORD on account of the Midianites, 8 the LORD sent a prophet
- MAN ACCOUNTABILITY → 10 And I said to you, 'I am the LORD your God; you shall not fear the gods of the Amorites in whose land you dwell.' But you have not obeyed my voice."

Why Accountability → a starting point for change -- you'll never see what God sees if blame shifting

• Jump ahead to vs 13 And Gideon said to him, "Please, sir, if the LORD is with us, why then has all this happened to us? And where are all his wonderful deeds that our fathers recounted to us, saying, 'Did not the LORD bring us up from Egypt?' But now the LORD has forsaken us and given us into the hand of Midian."

GOD reveals to Gideon how HE sees him → seemed to be in direct contrast to what was happening

• 11-14 Now the angel of the LORD came and sat under the terebinth at Ophrah, which belonged to Joash the Abiezrite, while his son Gideon was beating out wheat in the winepress to hide it from the Midianites. <u>SLIDE</u> 12 And the angel of the LORD appeared to him and said to him, "The LORD is with you, <u>O mighty man of valor.</u>"....(13 was read above)....14 And the LORD turned to him and said, "Go in this might of yours and save Israel from the hand of Midian; do not I send you?"

MAN Gideon reveals to God how he sees himself → Can You Recognize this? "BUT I AM WITH YOU"

• 15 And he said to him, "Please, Lord, how can I save Israel? Behold, my clan is the weakest in Manasseh, and I am the least in my father's house." 16 And the LORD said to him, "But I will be with you, and you shall strike the Midianites as one man."

Gideon tests the LORD - FEAR (if I have found favor v17) God deals w/obstacles & the building of altars

• 17 & 23-24 And he said to him, "If now I have found favor in your eyes, then show me a sign that it is you who speak with me...(brought food, fire rock, I have seen face to face)...But the LORD said to him, "Peace be to you. Do not fear; you shall not die." 24 Then Gideon built an altar there to the LORD and called it, The LORD is Peace. To this day it still stands at Ophrah, which belongs to the Abiezrites.

The LORD tests Gideon -- to deal with fear (its a hard step...Gideon takes baby step...celebrate swings)

• 25-27 That night the LORD said to him, "Take your father's bull, and the second bull seven years old, and pull down the altar of Baal that your father has, and cut down the Asherah that is beside it 26 and build an altar to the LORD your God on the top of the stronghold here, with stones laid in due order. <u>SLIDE</u> Then take the second bull and offer it as a burnt offering with the wood of the Asherah that you shall cut down." 27 So Gideon took ten men of his servants and did as the LORD had told him. (almost parenthetically) <u>But</u> because he was too afraid of his family and the men of the town to do it by day, he did it by night.

28-32 Gideon's name was called Jerubbaal- "Let Baal contend against him," - a new identity
A first step on the journey taking a man hiding in a winepress, to leading the way - fearful & faithful
33-35 The Spirit of the LORD clothed w/ Power - people are responding - new identity the ram's horn
36-40 The fleece: God continues to helps us overcome obstacles to become who He sees us to be
