What Was God Really After? - Judges Pt 07

REVIEW God is dealing with Gideon's heart of fear wanting him to see himself as God sees him

Jdg 7:2 **The LORD said to Gideon**, "You have too many warriors with you. If I let all of you fight the Midianites, the Israelites will boast to me that **they saved themselves by their own strength**. 3 Therefore, tell the people, **'Whoever is timid or afraid may leave this mountain and go home**." So 22,000 of them went home, leaving only 10,000 who were willing to fight.

- What is God after? (1) Gideon's Heart → still dominated by fear "You have too many warriors"
- What is God after? (2) He wanted former worshipers of Baal, to know Him → ONLY HE could do this
- If just fear -- why not deal with the fear of the 22,000 If just victory why not keep the 32,000
- 4 But the LORD told Gideon, "There are still too many! Bring them down to the spring, and I will test them to determine who will go with you and who will not."{2 groups, those who put water in their hand & lapped like dogs and those who bent to drink from the water}6 Only 300 of the men drank from their hands. All the others got down on their knees and drank with their mouths in the stream.

7 The LORD told Gideon, "With these 300 men I will rescue you and give you victory over the Midianites. Send all the others home."

- ullet With these 300 men o God pushing Gideon to the brink in order to deal with fear AND
 - \circ began with 4.5 to 1 odds, now it is 450 to 1 \rightarrow 1% of the original force
- What was God after? To know HIM → and OBEY him (lappers) I will rescue you and give you victory

9 That night the LORD said, "Get up! Go down into the Midianite camp, for I have given you victory over them! 10 But if you are afraid to attack, go down to the camp with your servant Purah. 11 Listen to what the Midianites are saying, and you will be greatly encouraged. Then you will be eager to attack."

• God → I've given you victory Heart → IF you are afraid, you'll be encouraged & eager to attack

{Gideon → enemy camp heard a man describe a dream - and now interpreted}

14 His companion answered, "Your dream can mean only one thing—God has given Gideon son of Joash, the Israelite, victory over Midian and all its allies!" 15 When Gideon heard the dream and its interpretation, he bowed in worship before the LORD.

- Maybe this is what God was after all along..."he bowed in worship before the LORD"
- Everything changed from this moment
- He who grew up in a house that worshipped Baal is now a worshiper of God

15(b) Then he returned to the Israelite camp and shouted, "Get up! For the LORD has given you victory over the Midianite hordes!"

- He sees things God's way (**LORD** v9 I have given victory, **Gideon** v 15 the Lord has given victory)
- He is no longer paralyzed by fear...It didn't matter he only had 300 men
- He didn't even worry about weapons -- he gave each a trumpet, a vase and a torch (HIS PLAN?)
- They surrounded the enemy and at the same time blew horns broke vases and torches shined
- 22 When the 300 Israelites blew their rams' horns, <u>the LORD caused</u> the warriors in the camp to fight against each other with their swords. Those who were not killed fled to places as far away as Beth-shittah near Zererah and to the border of Abel-meholah near Tabbath.

NEXT STEP

- What if all of God's dealings are designed primarily to move us to bow in worship to God?
- About God? He pursues us relentlessly, To capture our heart, yet He is patient and gentle in process
