SCENARIO - AND GOD's TIMING (hand over vs rescue)

Jdg 13:1-25 NLT Again the Israelites did evil in the LORD's sight, so the **LORD handed them over to the Philistines**, who oppressed them for forty years.....vs 5 [a new baby would be born \rightarrow and the LORD said] **He will begin to rescue Israel from the Philistines.**

God Encounters Manoah's Wife

An unnamed woman, a need, sorrow, no hope \rightarrow until she encountered God

• 2 In those days a man named Manoah from the tribe of Dan lived in the town of Zorah. His wife was unable to become pregnant, and they had no children. 3 The angel of the LORD appeared to Manoah's wife and said, "Even though you have been unable to have children, you will soon become pregnant and give birth to a son.

God's purpose for the child revealed before birth \rightarrow a woman w/ no hope giving birth to a deliverer

• 4 So be careful; you must not drink wine or any other alcoholic drink nor eat any forbidden food. 5 You will become pregnant and give birth to a son, and his hair must never be cut. For he will be dedicated to God as a Nazirite from birth. He will begin to rescue Israel from the Philistines."

Jer 1:5 NLT "I knew you before I formed you in your mother's womb. Before you were born I set you apart and appointed you as my prophet to the nations."

God Encounters Manoah (in the midst of his doubts and uncertainty)

She had an encounter with God → wanted to share with her husband (hard to keep quiet about it)

• 7 But he told me, 'You will become pregnant and give birth to a son. You must not drink wine or any other alcoholic drink nor eat any forbidden food. For your son will be dedicated to God as a Nazirite from the moment of his birth until the day of his death."

(Maybe didn't believe his wife, wanted more detail?) -- either way God answered and encountered him

• 8 Then Manoah prayed to the LORD, saying, "Lord, please let the man of God come back to us again and give us MORE INSTRUCTIONS about this son who is to be born." 9 God answered Manoah's prayer, and the angel of God appeared once again to his wife...

Manoah wanted details - The Lord basically said, "I gave your wife all you need to know, trust my word

• 12 So Manoah asked him, "When your words come true, what kind of rules should govern the boy's life and work?" 13 The angel of the LORD replied, "Be sure your wife follows the instructions I gave her. 16...(Manoah didn't realize it was the angel of the LORD.) → not just man of God vs 8

Manoah and His Wife Finally Realize Whom They Have Encountered

17 Then Manoah asked the angel of the LORD, "What is your name? For when all this comes true, we want to honor you." 18 "Why do you ask my name?" the angel of the LORD replied. "It is too wonderful for you to understand." 19 Then Manoah took a young goat and a grain offering and offered it on a rock as a sacrifice to the LORD. And as Manoah and his wife watched, the LORD did an amazing thing. 20 As the flames from the altar shot up toward the sky, the angel of the LORD ascended in the fire. When Manoah and his wife saw this, they fell with their faces to the ground.

Wonderful and amazing thing - same Hebrew word Means wonderful, incomprehensible, beyond
understanding. too marvelous for humans to grasp. (used in Isa 8:6 "His name shall be called
Wonderful Counselor..."

Manoah and His Wife Encountered Jesus - a Christophany

21 The angel did not appear again to Manoah and his wife. Manoah finally realized it was the angel of the LORD, 22 and he said to his wife, "We will certainly die, for we have seen God!"

Other places this happened in the Bible

- Hagar (Gen 16:7–13) The angel of the LORD found her... (v. 7), and Hagar says, "You are the God who sees me" (v. 13)
- Moses at the Burning Bush (Ex 3:2–6) The angel of the LORD appeared to him in a flame of fire..." (v. 2) The angel says, "I am the God of your father, the God of Abraham, Isaac, and Jacob" (v. 6) and commands worship.

He has an AMAZING name and he does AMAZING things...have you encountered him?

 Php 2:9-11 NLT Therefore, God elevated him to the place of highest honor and gave him the name above all other names, 10 that at the name of Jesus every knee should bow, in heaven and on earth and under the earth, 11 and every tongue declare that Jesus Christ is Lord, to the glory of God the Father.

God Encounters Samson (a blessing and a stirring)

24 When her son was born, she named him Samson. And the LORD blessed him as he grew up. 25 And the Spirit of the LORD began to stir him while he lived in Mahaneh-dan, which is located between the towns of Zorah and Eshtaol.

- He lived in the Camp of Dan close to the Philistines, God was stirring him, prodding him toward his
 calling right at the border where his mission will be played out
- It is a stirring, an inner restlessness, or something unsettling (troubled by a dream)
- God often works in us (stirring our hearts) before he works through us

Summary - Have you had an encounter with Jesus? You cannot meet him and be left unchanged

- 1) (WIFE) Do you need hope, a promise, a miracle you need an encounter with God
- 2) (SAMSON) Purpose in life?, blessing? Stirred by spirit? you need and encounter with God
- 3) (MANOAH) Are you dealing with doubts and uncertainty you need an encounter with God

When they had an encounter with the LORD Jesus Christ, falling on your knees before Him? When was the last time you sensed God stirring in your heart? Respond to it, he is moving you to your purpose.
