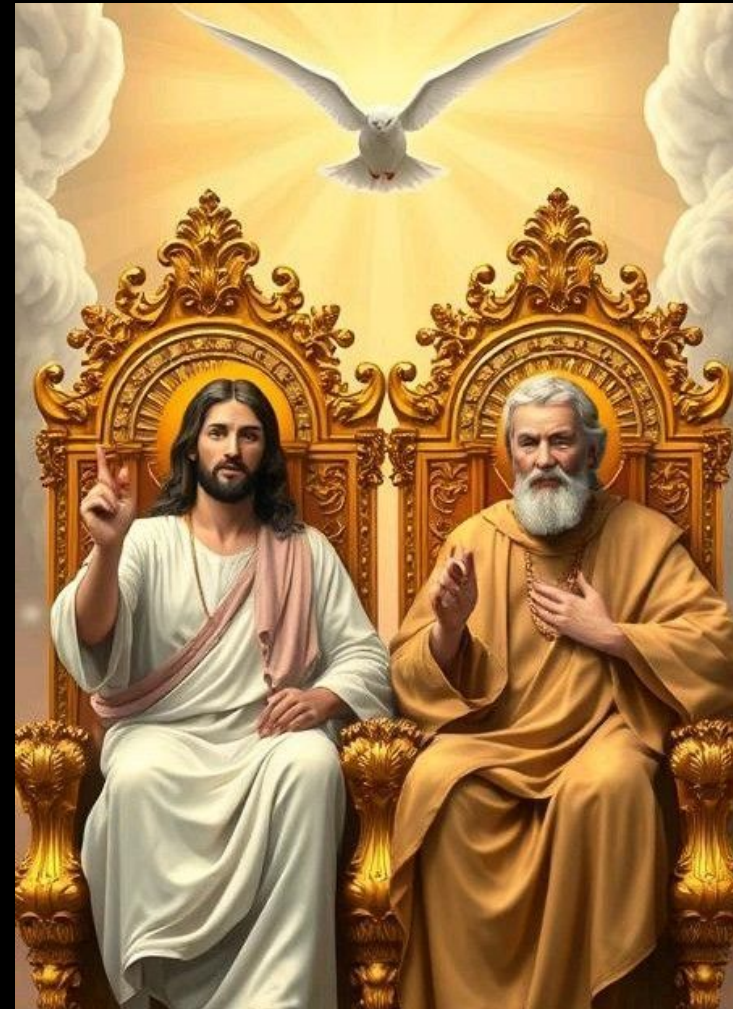


The Present Day Ministry of Jesus

Hebrews Part 09

Heb 8:1-5 Now the point in what we are saying is this: we have such **a high priest**, one who is seated at the right hand of the throne of the Majesty in heaven, (2) a minister **in the holy places**, in the **true tent that the Lord set up**, not man.(3) For every high priest is appointed to offer gifts and sacrifices; thus it is necessary for **this priest also to have something to offer.**

- We have one high priest
- Seated at God's right hand
- A minister in the holy places
- The TRUE tent the LORD set up
- His offering was His blood



He offered his own blood

Heb 9:12 he entered once for all into the holy places, not by means of the blood of goats and calves but **by means of his own blood**, thus securing an eternal redemption.

(4) Now if he were on earth, he would not be a priest at all, since there are **priests who offer gifts according to the law.** (5) They serve **a copy and shadow of the heavenly things.** For when Moses **was about to erect the tent,** he was instructed by God, saying, "See that you make everything according to the pattern that was shown you on the mountain."



- Many high priests over the years
- Standing once per year not seated perpetually
- This tent was a COPY Moses set up
- The offering was blood of goats and calves

His sacrifice is accepted - our sins forgiven

Heb 1:3... After making purification for sins, he sat down at the right hand of the Majesty on high.

Heb 10:12 But when Christ had offered for all time a single sacrifice for sins, he sat down at the right hand of God.

He intercedes for us on the journey

Heb 10:14 For by a single offering he has perfected for all time those who are being sanctified.

Heb 7:25 Consequently, he is able to save to the uttermost those who draw near to God through him, since he always lives to make intercession for them.

Confidence to enter the most holy place

Heb 4:14–16 Since then we have a great high priest who has passed through the heavens, Jesus, the Son of God, let us hold fast our confession. For we do not have a high priest who is unable to sympathize with our weaknesses, but one who in every respect has been tempted as we are, yet without sin. Let us then with confidence draw near to the throne of grace, that we may receive mercy and find grace to help in time of need.

Confidence to enter the most holy place

Heb 10:19–22 Therefore, brothers, since **we have confidence** to enter the holy places by the blood of Jesus...**let us draw near with a true heart in full assurance of faith.**

Waiting until his enemies are a footstool

Heb 10:12-13 But when Christ had offered for all time a single sacrifice for sins, he sat down at the right hand of God, (13) waiting from that time until his enemies should be made a footstool for his feet.
