

# The Structure of Revelation (addendum)

I wanted to spend a little time before going into the Seals, Trumpets and Vials and talk about the structure of the book. Expositors of the word have provided various outlines of the the book of Revelation. Obviously the structure one holds to tends to influence his interpretation of the book.

## Chronological / Sequential Structure

This view follows a sequential chronological path.

## Progressive Parallel Structure

This view says there are seven sections in Revelation, and these seven sections run parallel from the first coming of Christ until His second coming.

- 3) Seven Trumpets (Rev 8-11)

- 6) The Judgment of Babylon (Rev 17-19)
- 7) The Judgments on Satan and His Hosts & the New Heavens and New Earth (Rev 20-22)

## The Heaven and Earth Structure<sup>1</sup>

As you go through the chapters of Revelation you will notice that John sees things first in heaven, then he sees the resultant action on earth. The place of the visions is heaven, God's dwelling place -- the fulfillment of the visions is earth, man's dwelling place.

## Christian Millennialist Structure<sup>2</sup>

Christian Millennialist, a structure coined by Kevin J. Connor in order to classify his beliefs as to a millennium. He does not hold to a “**Jewish Millennium**” wherein the Mosaic economy is restored. Also designating that he is not an “**A-Millennialist**” who believes the church is in the millennium now.

Within the Christian Millennialist view Connor believes there are parts of the other views that hold merit. For example: There would be **some chapters that would fulfill progressive parallelism** (11, 12, 13, 14, 15, 16,,17, 18 and consummate with Chapter 19).

**Connor comes to this conclusion for two reasons:**

- 1) **Time Period** - the time period mentioned in Revelation 11, 12 and 13 is three and a half years. This should be seen as depicting different events during the same 3.5 years rather than a total of 10.5 years... This is obviously dependant upon your interpretation.

**It would look like this**

<b><u>Three &amp; One Half Years</u></b>
1) Revelation 11 (1,260 days)
2) Revelation 11 (forty two months)
3) Revelation 12 - Time, Times and Half a Time
4) Revelation 13 - Time, Times and Half a Time

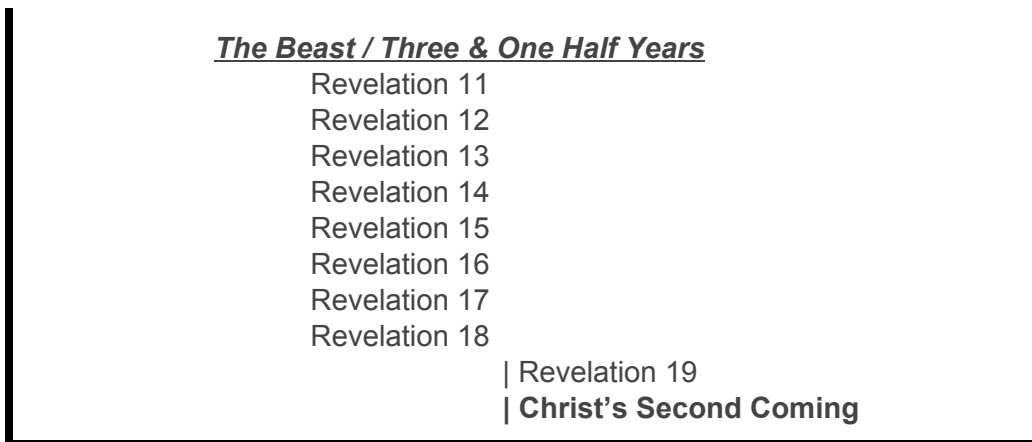

- 2) **The Beast** - the time period mentioned in Revelation 11, 12 and 13 is three and a half years. The first mention of the beast is Rev 11:7, the final mention is Rev 20:10...(at least 37 mentions).

When comparing Daniel 7 with Revelation 13 you will see “the little horn” of Daniel and “the beast” of Revelation both make war with the saints for three and one-half years...the conclusion is “the beast” and “the little horn” are both speaking of the same thing. So “the beast” and the “time, times and half a time” would fall into a progressive parallelism model which looks like this.

It would look like this



The Christian Millennialist Structure is sort of a hybrid where most of the chapters fall into the Chronological Structure and some into the Progressive Parallel Structure.

**The “Then I Saw” Structure**

This structure breaks up the book of Revelation based on the “Then I Saw” statements of John, where each of these seems to be a breaking point describing something new.

Rev 5:1-2 NIV **Then I saw** in the right hand of him who sat on the throne a scroll with writing on both sides and sealed with seven seals. 2 And I saw a mighty angel proclaiming in a loud voice, "Who is worthy to break the seals and open the scroll?"

Rev 5:6 NIV **Then I saw** a Lamb, looking as if it had been slain, standing at the center of the throne, encircled by the four living creatures and the elders. The Lamb had seven horns and seven eyes, which are the seven spirits of God sent out into all the earth.

Rev 7:2 NIV **Then I saw** another angel coming up from the east, having the seal of the living God. He called out in a loud voice to the four angels who had been given power to harm the land and the sea:

Rev 10:1 NIV **Then I saw** another mighty angel coming down from heaven. He was robed in a cloud, with a rainbow above his head; his face was like the sun, and his legs were like fiery pillars.

Rev 13:11 NIV **Then I saw** a second beast, coming out of the earth. It had two horns like a lamb, but it spoke like a dragon.

Rev 14:6 NIV **Then I saw** another angel flying in midair, and he had the eternal gospel to proclaim to those who live on the earth--to every nation, tribe, language and people.

Rev 16:13 NIV **Then I saw** three impure spirits that looked like frogs; they came out of the mouth of the dragon, out of the mouth of the beast and out of the mouth of the false prophet.

Rev 19:19 NIV **Then I saw** the beast and the kings of the earth and their armies gathered together to wage war against the rider on the horse and his army.

Rev 20:11-12 NIV **Then I saw** a great white throne and him who was seated on it. The earth and the heavens fled from his presence, and there was no place for them. 12 And I saw the dead, great and small, standing before the throne, and books were opened. Another book was opened, which is the book of life. The dead were judged according to what they had done as recorded in the books.

Rev 21:1-2 NIV **Then I saw** "a new heaven and a new earth," for the first heaven and the first earth had passed away, and there was no longer any sea. 2 I saw the Holy City, the new Jerusalem, coming down out of heaven from God, prepared as a bride beautifully dressed for her husband.

### **Chiastic Structure**<sup>3</sup>

A chiasm (also called a chiasmus) is a literary device in which a sequence of ideas is presented and then repeated *in reverse order*. The result is a "mirror" effect as the ideas are "reflected" back in a passage. Each idea is connected to its "reflection" by a repeated word, often in a related form. The term *chiasm* comes from the Greek letter *chi*, which looks like our letter X. Chiastic pattern is also called "ring structure."

**Sample chiastic pattern ABCDXDCBA** (two A's have a match, the two B's have a match etc). Here is an example from Scripture(Matt 6:24)<sup>4</sup>

- (A) No one can **serve two masters**;
- (B) for either he will **hate** the one
- (C) and **love** the other,
- (C') or he will be **devoted** to one
- (B') and **despise** the other.
- (A') You cannot **serve God and wealth**.

Here is one idea of how the chiastic structure might look in the book of Revelation.<sup>5</sup>
